Dear Ms. Crandall:

By the email correspondence received by Tampa Electric Company (TEC) on May 9, 2012, the Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP) announced its intent to issue an air construction permit for the Polk Power Station located in Polk County, Florida. TEC has reviewed the intent to issue the construction permit along with the proposed conditions and are currently working with FDEP to resolve certain issues with the conditions of this proposed permit.

To accommodate further discussions with staff of the FDEP on these issues, we request that the time for Tampa Electric Company to petition for a formal administrative hearing be extended to the close of business on July 6, 2012. TEC believes that this time will be sufficient to amicably resolve the issues without the necessity of pursuing a formal administrative hearing.
