

The Department of Environ-mental Protection (Department) gives notice of its intent to issue a Prevention of Significant Determention (PSD) permit modification to Georgia-Pacific Corporation for the No. 3 Bleach Plant localled in Putnem County, Flor ida. A construction permit was lesued to Georgia-Pacific in June 1999 to replace two bleach plants with a new elemental chlorine-tres bleach low increase of the Carbon Monoxide emission rate and reduce the daily maximum production rate for the No. 3 Bleach Plant. A Best Available Control Technology (BACT) determination was required for carbon monoxide (CO) pursuant to Rule 62-212 400, F.A.C.
