Dear Mr. Frost:

On January 25, 2010, we received request for an air construction permit extension for modifications to No. 4 combination boiler under permit 1070005-045-AC (PSD-FL-393) at the Palatka Mill. The facility is located in Putnam County at 215 County Road 216 in Palatka, Florida. The application was deemed incomplete and we requested additional information needed to process your application on February 15, 2010. We have not yet received the requested additional information. Rule 62-4.055(1) of the Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.) requires the following:

"The applicant shall have **ninety days** after the Department mails a timely request for additional information to submit that information to the Department. If an applicant requires more than ninety days in which to respond to a request for additional information, the applicant may notify the Department in writing of the circumstances, at which time the application shall be held in active status for one additional period of up to ninety days. Additional extensions shall be granted for good cause shown by the applicant. A showing that the applicant is making a diligent effort to obtain the requested additional information shall constitute good cause. Failure of an applicant to provide the timely requested information by the applicable deadline shall result in denial of the application."

It has been more than 53 days since our request for additional information (copy attached). You are reminded that the permit processing time clock has stopped for this project and that we will not continue our review until we receive the additional information. If you require a period of time in addition to the 90 days allowed by rule, please submit a written request indicating the amount of time necessary. If you fail to provide the additional information or request additional time to submit the additional information, we will deny your application for air permit. No. 4 Combination Boiler, Request to Extend Permit Expiration Date

Dear Mr. Frost:

On January 25, 2010, the Department received a request for an air construction permit expiration date extension. The affected permit is 1070005-045-AC/PSD-FL-393, which was issued for modifications to the No. 4 combination boiler (CB). The application is incomplete. Based on our review of the proposed project, we have determined that the following additional information is needed in order to continue processing this request. Please provide all assumptions, calculations and reference materials that are used or reflected in any of your responses to the following issues:

- 1. Please review the original netting table for Permit No. 1070005-045-AC/PSD-FL-393. Please revise this table for any emissions decreases or increases that are no longer within the contemporaneous 5-year period prior to the project.
- 2. The original permit was issued on September 26, 2008, and expires on March 26, 2010. The permit included a determination of best available control technology (BACT) for carbon monoxide (CO), nitrogen oxides (NOx), particulate matter (PM), PM with an aerodynamic diameter equal to 10 microns or less (PM₁₀) and volatile organic compounds (VOC). Condition No. 7 in Section 2 of the original permit requires construction to commence within 18 months of receipt of the permit in accordance with Rule 62-212.400(12), Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.). Because construction has not yet begun and the 18-month period ends on March 26, 2010, then authorization to construct will expire on this date pursuant to Rule 62-212.400(12)(a), F.A.C., Source Obligation. Therefore, provide a revalidation of the BACT determinations for the affected pollutants and for any new pollutants that may be affected if there are any changes to the contemporaneous increases and decreases and an update to the netting table.
- 3. Regarding modeling, if there are any changes that need to be reviewed, please address and submit as appropriate. In addition, if there are any increment issues that need to be reviewed, please address and submit as appropriate. Also, if there are any impact issues that need to be reviewed, please address and submit as appropriate.
- 4. Please provide an update of the progress toward the elimination of No. 6 fuel oil and the conversion to natural gas for the No. 4 combination boiler, since the creditable SO₂ reductions depend on this action.

The above information is requested pursuant to the following F.A.C. regulations: Rule 62-4.050 (Procedures to Obtain Permits and Other Authorizations; Applications); 62-4.055 (Permit Processing); 62-4.070 (Standards for Issuing or Denying Permits; Issuance, Denial); 62-4.120 (Construction Permits); 62-204.800 (Federal Regulations Adopted by Reference); 62-212.300 (Permits Required); 62-210.370 (Emissions Computations and Reporting); 62-210.900 (Forms and Instructions); 62-212.300 (General Preconstruction Review); and 62-212.400 (Prevention of Significant Deterioration). All applications for a Department permit must be certified by a professional engineer registered in the State of Florida pursuant to Rule 62-4.050(3), F.A.C. This requirement also applies to responses to Department requests for additional information of an engineering nature. For any material changes to the application, please include a new certification statement by the authorized representative or responsible official.

We will resume processing your application after receipt of the requested information. You are reminded that Rule 62-4.055(1), F.A.C., requires applicants to respond to requests for information within 90 days or to provide a written request for an additional period of time to submit the information.
