STATE OF FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL REGULATION NOTICE OF INTENT TO ISSUE

The Department of Environmental Regulation gives notice of its intent to revise the State Implementation Plan pursuant to 40 CFR Part 51, and issue a PSD permit to Florida Power & Light Company, P.O. Box 078768, West Palm Beach, Florida 33407-0768, to allow the temporary testing of Orimulsion fuel. A determination of Best Available Control Technology (BACT) was not required. The proposed project is subject to Prevention of Significant Deterioration (PSD) regulations. For particulate matter, the maximum concentration due to the test burn alone is predicted to be less than the significant impact levels. For sulfur dioxide, the maximum concentrations due to the Sanford plant and other sources are predicted to be below the AAQS and PSD Class II increments. Class II sulfur dioxide PSD increment assumption is 348 vs. 512 allowable 3-hour average, 59 vs. 91 allowable 24-hour average, and 4.8 vs. 20 allowable average in micrograms per cubic meter, respectively. These emissions are not expected to cause or contribute to a violation of any ambient air quality standard (AAQS). The Department is issuing this Intent to Issue for the reasons stated in the Technical Evaluation and Preliminary Determination.

A person whose substantial interests are affected by the Department's proposed permitting decision may petition for an administrative proceeding (hearing) in accordance with Section 120.57, F.S. The petition must contain the information set forth below and must be filed (received) in the Office of General Counsel of the Department at 2600 Blair Stone Road, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-2400, within 14 days of publication of this notice. Petitioner shall mail a copy of the petition to the applicant at the address indicated above at the time of filing. Failure to file petition within this time period shall constitute a waiver of any right such person may have to request a hearing under Section 120.57, F.S.

The Petition shall contain the following information: (a) The name, address, and telephone number of each petitioner, the applicant's name and address, the Department Permit File Number and the county in which the project is proposed; (b) A statement of how and when each petitioner received notice of the Department's action or proposed action; (c) A statement of how each petitioner's substantial interests are affected by the Department's action or proposed action; (d) A statement of the material facts disputed by Petitioner, if any; (e) A statement of facts which petitioner contends warrant reversal or modification of the Department's action or proposed action; (f) A statement of which rules or statutes petitioner contends require reversal or modification of the Department's action or proposed action; and (g) A statement of the relief sought by petitioner, stating precisely the action petitioner wants the Department to take with respect to the Department's action or proposed action.
