Project: The applicant has submitted a complete and certified Clean Air Interstate Rule (CAIR) Part Form and has requested its incorporation into the existing Title V air operation permit. This facility consists of four simple cycle combustion turbine (CT) peaking units, all of which are pre-NSPS (New Source Performance Standards) sources. Each CT exhausts through a separate stack. Emissions from the CT are uncontrolled. Also included are miscellaneous unregulated/insignificant emissions units and/or activities.
