This facility consists of
four simple cycle combustion turbine (CT) peaking
units, all of which are preNSPS sources. The CT's
may only fire new No. 2 fuel
oil having a maximum sulfur content of 0.5 percent,
by weight. Each CT exhausts, through a seporate
stack. Emissions from the
CT are uncontrolled. Because these emission units
have no add-on control devices, they are not subject to
CAM. Also included in this
permit are miscellaneous
unregulated/insignificant
emissions units and/or activities.
The Initial DRAFT Title V
permit contained three (3)

emissions units and/or activities.

The Initial DRAFT Title V permit contained three (3) existing steam generating emissions units, which were SG 2, SG 3, and SG 4. On January 1, 1998, they were permanently retired. All references made to these emissions units have been deleted from the text and tobles. However, they are still referenced in the Acid Rain Part, which is Section IV of the permit.

The permitting authority will issue the PROPOSED Permit, and subsequent FINAL Permit, in accordance

with the conditions of the DRAFT Permit unless a response received in accordance with the following procedures results in a different decision or significant change of terms or conditions.

A person whose substantial interests are affected by the proposed permitting decision may petition for an administrative hearing in accordance with Sections 120.569 and 120.57 of the Florida Statutes (5.7 of the Petition must contain the information set forth below and must be filed (received) in the Office of General Counsel of the Department of Environmental Protection, 3900 Commonwealth Boulevard, Mail Station 435, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-3000 (Telephone: 850/245-2242; Fax: 850/245-2303). Petitions filed by any persons other than those entitled to written notice undre Section 120.60(3), F.S., however, any person who asked the permitting authority for notice of agency action may file a petition within fourteen days of receipt of the notice of intent, whichever occurs first. Under Section 120.60(3), F.S., however, any person, who asked the permitting authority for notice of agency action may file a petition within fourteen days of receipt of that notice, regardless of the date of publication. A petitioner shall mail

a copy of the petition to the applicant at the address indicated above, at the time of filling. The failure of any person to file a petition within the applicable time period shall constitute a waiver of that person's right to request an administrative determination; (heering) under Sections 120.569 and 120.57, F.S., or to intervene in this proceeding and participate as a party to it. Any subsequent intervention will be only at the approval of the presiding officer upon the filing of a motion in compliance with Rule 28. 106.205 of the Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.). A petition that disputes the material facts on which the permitting authority's action is based must contain the following information:

(a) The name and address of each agency if file or identification number, if known;

A petition that does not dispute the material facts upon which the permitting authority's action is based shall state that no such facts are in dispute and otherwise shall contain the same information as set forth above, as required by Rule 28-106.301, F.A.C.

Because the administrative hearing process is designed to formulate final agency action, the filling of a petition means that the permitting authority's final action may be different from the position taken by it in this notice of intent. Persons whose substantial interests will be affected by any such final decision of the permitting authority on the application have the right to petition to become a party to the proceeding.
