

Kelly Generating Station, which is located in Alachua County at 605 SE 3rd Street, Gainesville, Florida Project: The applicant applied on July 1, 2008 to the Department for a Title V air operation permit renewal. This is a renewal of Title V air operation permit No. 0010005-005-AV. The existing facility consists primarily of: one fossil fuel fired steam generator (Unit -007); a combined-cycle unit consisting of a combustion turbine and a heat recovery steam generator (Unit -010); and, three unregulated simple-cycle combustion turbines (Unit -009). The facility utilizes natural gas, distillate fuel oils (Nos. 1 or 2), residual fuel oil (Nos. 4, 5 or 6), and onspecification used oil. There are fuel type restrictions for the respective emissions units. In addition, included in this permit are miscellaneous insignificant emissions units and/or activities Permitting Authority: Applications for Title V air operation permits are subject to review in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 403, Florida Statutes (F.S.) and Chapters 62-4, 62-210, 62-213 and 62-214, of the Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.).
