Under Section 120 60(3), FS. however, any person who asked the permitting authority for notice of agency action may file a petition within fourteen (14) days of receipt of that notice, regardless of the date of publication. A petition that does not dispute, the material facts upon which the permitting authority's action is based shall state that no such facts are in dispute and otherwise shall contain the same information as set forth above, as required by

Rule 28-106.301, F.A.C. Because the administrative hearing process is "de-signed to formulate final agency action, the filing of a petition means that the permitting authority's final action may be different from the position taken by it in this notice of intent. Persons whose substantial interests will be affected by any such final decision of the permitting authority on the application have the right to petition to become a party to the proceeding. in accordance with the re-quirements set forth above.
