



Facility Location: The applicant operates the existing Cape Canaveral Plant, which is located in Brevard County on the West side of the Indian River, approximately eight miles North of Cocoa, Florida on U.S. Highway One.

Project: The applicant applied on May 19, 2009, to the Department, for a Title V air operation permit renewal. This is a renewal of Title V air operation permit No. 0090006-003-AV. This facility consists of two oil and natural gas fired conventional steam electric generating stations, designated as Unit 1 and Unit 2. Each steam unit is a nominal 400 megawatt (MW) class (electric) steam generator which drives a single reheat turbine generator. Also included in this permit are miscellaneous unregulated/insignificant emissions units and/or activities.

Permitting Authority: Applications for Title V air operation permits for facilities that contain Acid Rain units are subject to review in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 403, Florida Statutes (F.S.) and Chapters 62-4, 46-210, 62-213 and 62-214, of the Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.). The proposed project is not exempt from air permitting requirements and a Title V air operation permit is required to operate the facility. The Bureau of Air Regulation is the Permitting Authority responsible for making a permit determination for this project.
