Cape Canaveral Plant
The Department of Environmental Protection (permitting authority)
gives notice of its intent to Issue a Title V air operation permit renewal to the Florida Power & Light Company for the Cape Canaveral
Plant located on the West side of the Indian River, approximately
eight miles north of Cocoa, Florida on U.S. Highway No. 1, Brevard
Courth. The applicant's name and address are: Mr. Lowell Trotter,
Forida Power & Light Company, Environmental Services Department, P.O. Box 1800, Juno Beach, Fl. 3308.
This facility consists of two oil and natural gas fired conventional
steam electric generalms stations, designaled as Units #I and #2.
These emissions units are regulated under Acid Rain, Phase II, and
Rue &2-96-805, F.A.C., Fossil Fuel Steam Generators with more than
250 million Bits per Hour Heal Input.
The permitting authority will issue the Title V PROPOSED Permit,
and subsequent Title V PINAL Permit, in accordance with the conditions of the Title V DRAFT Permit unless a response received in
accordance with the following procedures results in a different decision or significant change of terms or conditions.
The permitting authority will accest written comments and requests
for public meetings concerning the proposed Title V DRAFT Permit
issuance action for a period of 30 (Hinryl) days from the date of
publication #5505, Tallahassee, Florida 3239-2400, Any written
comments field shall be made available for public inspection, if written comments received result in a significant change in this DRAFT
Permit, the permitting authority will accest written comments and requests
for public meetings concerning the proposed DRAFT Permit
and neoure, if applicable, another Public Notice.

A person whose substantial Interests are affected by the proposed
permitting decision may petition for an administrative hearing i

any; (e) A statement of the facts that the petitioner contends warrant reversal or modification of the permitting authority's action or pro-

reversal or moonication or the permitting authority's action or pro-posed action;

(f) A statement identifying the rules or statutes that the petitioner contrends require reversal or modification of the permitting authori-ly's action or proposed action; and

(g) A statement of the relief sought by the petitioner, stating precisely the action that the petitioners wants the permitting authority to take with respect to the action or proposed action addressed in this notice of intent.

Because the administrative hearing propose is designed to formulate

in e action that the perincipal waits the perinting authority to take with respect to the action or proposed action addressed in this notice of intent. Because the administrative hearing process is designed to formulate final agency action, the filting of a petition means that the permitting in authority's final action may be different from the position taken by it in this notice of intent. Persons whose substantial interests will be affected by any such final decision of the permitting authority on the application have the right to petition to become a party to the proceeding, in accordance with the requirements set forth above. Mediation is not available for this proceeding, in accordance with the requirement set forth above. Mediation is not available for this proceeding. In addition to the above, pursuant to 42 United States Code (U.S.C.) Section 7661d(b)(2), any person may petition the Administrator of the EPA within 60 (sixty) days of the expiration of the Administrator of \$45 (forty-five) day review period as established at 42 U.S.C. Section 7661d(b)(1), to object to issuance of army permit. Any petition shall be based only on objections to the permit that were raised with reasonable specificity during the 30 (thirty) day public comment period provided in this notice, unless the petitioner demonstrates to the Administrator of the EPA that it was impracticable to raise such objection within the comment period or unless the grounds for such objection arose after the comment period. Filling of a petition with the Administrator of the EPA does not stay the effective date of any permit properly issued pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 62-213, F.A.C. Petitions filed with the Administrator of EPA must meet the requirements of 42 U.S.C. Section 7661d(b)(2) and must be filed with the Administrator of the EPA 4 410 M. Street, SW.
