



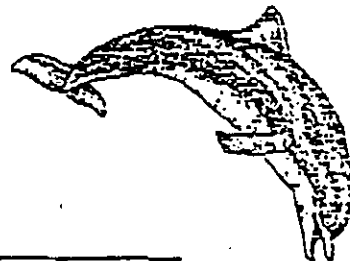

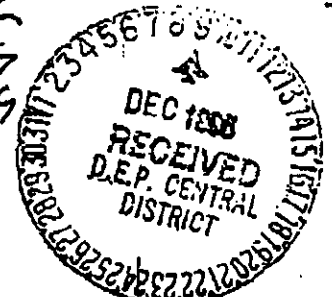

Please regard this letter as the Orlando Utilities Commission's request for a modification to the above referenced permit to change the annual compliance testing date required in Specific Condition No. 11. As we have previously discussed with you, compliance testing of combustion turbines at any time other than late summer may require operation of these units solely for the purpose of testing. (i.e. backing down coal generation in order to operate the combustion turbines). Testing under this scenario could more than double or triple the cost of the required compliance testing.

On November 22, 1995, the FDEP issued a guidance memorandum relating to the testing of gas turbines making it possible to perform compliance testing on these units during high ambient temperatures without requiring a restriction on the maximum load allowed. The Orlando Utilities Commission wishes to take advantage of this guidance memorandum and is requesting that the required testing date as found in Specific Condition 11 be changed as follows:

- 11. The required compliance tests shall be conducted annually between July 1 and August 31.

(i.e. backing down coal generation in order to operate the combustion turbines). Testing under this scenario could more than double or triple the cost of the required compliance testing.

The guidance memorandum also clarifies that it is not necessary to correct the measured value of NO_x to iso ambient conditions therefore; Specific Condition No 10 should be deleted from our permit.


