The Department of Environmental Protection (Department) gives notice of its intent to issue an air construction permit to Sea Ray Boats, Inc., for the Cape Canaveral Plant located at 1200 Sea Ray Drive, Merritt Island, Brevard County. This construction permit to allow boat repair operations in the building that was originally intended for boat manufacturing operations. The Department will accept written comments concerning the proposed permit issuance action for a period of fourteen (14) days from the date of poublication of this Public Notice of Intent to Issue Air Construction Permit, Written comments should be provided to the Department's Bureau of Air Regulation at 2600 Blair Stone Road, Mail Station #5505, Tallahassee, FL 23299-2400, Any written comments fled shall be made available for public inspection. If written comments received result in a significant change in the proposed agency action, the Department shall revise the proposed permit and require, if applicable, another Public Notice.

The Department will issue the permit with the attached conditions unless a timely petition for an administrative hearing is filed pursuant to sections 120.589 and 120.57 F.S., before the deadline for filling a petition. The procedures for petitioning for a hearing are set forth below. Mediation is not available in the is proceeding.

A person whose substantial interests are affected by the proposed permitting decision may petition for an administrative proceeding (hearing) under sections 120.589 and 120.57 of the Florida Statutes. The petition must contain the information set forth below and must be fled (received) in the Office of General Counsel of the Department at 3900 Commonwealth Boulevard, Mail Station #35. Tallahassee, Florida, 32399-3000, Petitions filed by the permit applicant or any of the parties below must be filed within fourteen days of receipt of this notice of intent. Petitions sited any persons other than those entitled to written notice under section 120.60(3) of the Florida Statutes must be filed within fourteen days of publication of the public notice or within fourteen days of publication of the public notice or within fourteen days of receipt of this notice of intent, whichever occurs first. Under section 120.60(3), however, any person who asked the Department for notice of agency action may file a petition within fourteen days of receipt of that notice, regardless of the date of publication. A petitioner shall mail a copy of the petition to the applicant at the address indicated above at the lime of filing. The failure of any person to file a petition within the appropriate lime period shall constitute a waiver of that person's right to request an administrative determination (hearing) under sections 120.569 and 120.57 F.S., or to intervene in this proceeding and participate as a party to it. Any subsequent intervention will be only at the approach o

approval of the presiding officer upon the filing of a motion in compliance with Rule 28-106.205 of the Florida Administrative Code.

A petition that disputes the material facts on which the Department's action is based must contain the following information:

(a) The name and address of each agency affected and each agency's file or identification number, if known: (b) The name, address, and telephone number of the petitioner, the name, address, and telephone number of the petitioner's representative, if any, which shall be the address for service purposes during the course of the proceeding: and explanation of how the petitioner's substantial interests will be affected by the agency determination; (c) A statement of how and when petitioner received notice of the agency action or proposed action; (d) A statement of all disputed issues of material fact. If there are none, the petition must so indicate; (e) A concise statement of the utilimate facts allleged, including specific facts the petitioner contends variant reveral or modifications of the agency's proposed action; (f) A statement of the specific rules or statutes the petitioner require reversal or modifications of the agency's proposed action; and (g) A statement of the relief sought by the petitioner, stating precisely the action petitioner wishes the agency to lake the respect to the agency's proposed action.

A petition that does not dispute the material facts upon which the Department's action is based shall state that no such facts are in dispute and otherwise shall contain the same information as set forth above, as required by rule 28-108.301
