A person whose substantial interests are affected by the proposed permitting decision may petition for an administrative hearing in accordance with Sections 120,569 and 120,57 of the Florida Statutes (F.S.). The petition must contain the information set forth below and must be filed (received) in the Office of General Counsel of the Department of Environmental Protection, 3900 Commonweith Boulevard, Mail Station #35, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-3000 (Telephone 850/455-9730; Fax 850/487-4938). Petitions filed by any persons other than those entitled to written notice under Section 120 60(3), F.S., must be filed within 14 (four teen) days of publication of the public notice or writiin 14 (four teen) days of publication of the public notice or writiin 14 (four teen) days of person who asked the permitting authority for notice of agency action may file a petition within 14 (four teen) days of receipt of that notice, regardless of the date of publication. (f) A statement of the specific rules or statutes the petitioner contends require reversal or modification of the agency's proposed action; and,

(g) A statement of the relief sought by the petitioner, stating precisely the action petitioner wishes the agency to take with respect to the agency's proposed action.

tion. A petition that does not dispute the material facts upon which he permitting authority's action is based shall state that no such facts are in dispute and otherwise shall contain the same information as set forth above, as required by Rule 28-106.301,F.A.C.

Because the administrative hearing process is designed to formulate final agency action, the filling of a petition means that the permitting authority's final action may be different from the position taken by it in this notice of intent. Persons whose substantial interests will be affected by any such final decision of the permitting authority on the applications; shave the right to petition to become a party to the proceeding, in accordance with the requirements set forth above. Mediation is not available for this proceeding, and addition to the above, pursuant to 42 United States Code (U.S.C.) Section 7661 d(b)(2), any person may petition the Administrator of the EPA within 60 (six-yi) days of the expiration of the Administrator's 45 (forty-live) day review period as established at 42 U.S.C. Section 7661 (b)(l), to object to issuance of any permit revision, Any petition shall be based only on objections to the permit revision that were raised with reasonable specificity during the 30 (thirty) day public comment period provided in this notice, unless the petitioner demonstrates to the Administrator of the EPA that it was impracticable to raise such objections within the comment period. Filling of a petition with the Administrator of the EPA does not stay the effective date of any permit properly issued pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 62-213, F.A.C. Petitions filed with the Administrator of EPA must meet the requirements of 42 U.S.C. Section 7661d(b)(2) and must be filed with the Administrator of the EPA at U.S. EPA, 401 M. Street, 5 W., Washington, D.C. 20460.
