The Department of Environmental Protection (Permitting Authority) gives notice of its intent to issue an Air Construction Permit Modification and a Title V Air Operation Permit Revision to Wheelabrator North Broward Inc., for the Waste-to-Energy Facility located at 2600 N.W. 48th Street, Pompano Beach, Broward County. The owner's name and address are: Wheelabrator North Broward, Inc., 2600 N. 48th Street, Pompano Beach, Broward County, Fl. 33073.

The air construction permit modification and corresponding Title V permit revision, are to increase the lime silo filling rate from 40,000 to 50,000 pounds perhour. Lime is used in a spray dryer to control acid gases from the three municipal waste combustors located at the site. The material is delivered to the site by truck and pneumatically conveyed to the silo Emissions are controlled by a baghouse. The Department has determined that the present 5 percent opacity limitation is sufficient to control the particulate emissions from this operation.

The permitting authority will issue the Air Construction Permit and the PRO-POSED Title V Air Operation Permit Revision and subsequent FINAL Title V Air Operation Permit and the PRO-POSED Title V Air Operation Permit Revision in accordance with the conditions of the Draft Air Construction Permit and the DRAFT Title V Air Operation Permit Revision unless a response received in accordance with the following procedures results in a different decision or significant change of terms or conditions.
