SECOND REQUEST FOR ENLARGEMENT OF TIME

As good cause for granting this request, FPL states the following:

- 1. On or about May 23, 2008, FPL received from the Department of Environmental Protection ("Department") a "Written Notice of Intent to Issue Air Permit" and accompanying "Draft Permit" (Air Permit No. 0250003-008-AC), for FPL's Turkey Point Fossil Plant, which is located at 9700 SW 344th Street, Homestead, Miami-Dade County, Florida.
- 2. Based on FPL's initial review, the Draft Permit and associated documents contain several provisions that warrant clarification or correction.
- 3. On June 5, 2008, FPL filed its first Request for Enlargement of Time with the Department, requesting additional time for filing of a Petition for Administrative Proceedings in regard to the Department's Intent to Issue Air Permit. FPL requested that the time be extended until June 23, 2008.

- 4. As of the date of filing this Second Request, FPL has not received from the Department an order enlarging time, although representatives of the Department had stated that such an order would be issued.
- 5. Representatives of FPL and the Department are continuing to discuss possible resolutions to the issues needing clarification or correction.
- 6. This request is filed simply as a protective measure to avoid waiver of FPL's right to challenge certain conditions contained in the Draft Permit. Grant of this request will not prejudice either party, but will further their mutual interest and hopefully avoid the need to file a Petition and proceed to a formal administrative hearing. A representative of FPL has conferred with staff of the Department who had no objection to this second request.

WHEREFORE, FPL respectfully requests that the time for filing of a Petition for Administrative Proceedings in regard to the Department's Intent to Issue Air Permit No.0250003-008-AC be formally extended to and including July 23, 2008.
