Dear Mr. Brussels:

For the St. Johns River Power Park's Boilers Nos. 1 and 2, a carbon monoxide emission limitation was imposed in the above referenced Title V permit in specific condition No. D.18. This limitation was derived from a BACT determination issued by the Department dated May 7, 1981. At this time, the Department only had partial delegation of the PSD program, meaning that EPA Region 4 had the responsibility of issuing final PSD permits for Florida. As such, EPA decided not to carry forth the CO emission limitation in the final PSD permit (PSD-FL-010), but did carry forth all other pollutants and their limitations addressed/established in the BACT determination. In conclusion, this emission limitation should not have been imposed in the initial Title V permit. Therefore, this letter is temporarily suspending the condition until it can be removed formally through the appropriate Title V permitting process, which is currently in the works (i.e., opening for cause to add the Phase II NOx emission limitations).
