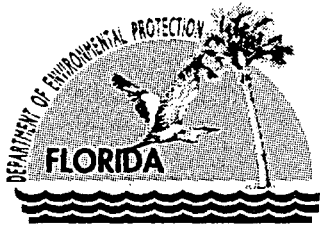

The Department has received the application for revision on August 9, 2002, for the incorporation of the repowering project at JEA's Northside Generating Station. Based on our initial review of the proposed project, we have determined that additional information is needed in order to continue processing this application package. Please provide all assumptions, calculations, and reference material(s), that are used or reflected in any of your responses to the following issues:

1. Based on the initial performance testing conducted May 20 and 21, 2002, pursuant to 40 CFR 60.8, the particulate matter (PM) filter catches were less than 50 mgs during the 3 (three) 1-hr tests. Therefore, and per the Department's conversations with the U.S. EPA, Region 4, the subsequent initial compliance tests for all PM test runs will have to be conducted for a minimum duration of 120 minutes pursuant to 40 CR 60, Subpart Da. Once the test results have been received and compliance demonstrated, we will resume permitting of the request.
