Pursuant to your letter dated April 5, 2002, please be advised that Trail Ridge Landfill may be deemed a synthetic area source. The facility currently does not meet the criteria as its Potential to Emit with controls for HAP's is below the threshold of 10 tons/year for a single HAP and 25 tons/ year for any combination of HAP's.

It is our understanding that the facility being a synthetic area source is exempt from filing a Part I application. However, in order to comply with Section 112(j) notification and help the permitting authority make a case-by-case determination, we have attempted to provide you with the following information:
