CF Industries, Inc. Plant City Phosphate Complex Hillsborough County

The Department of Environmental Protection (Department) gives notice of its intent to issue a air permit modification to CF Industries, Inc., for the Plant City Phosphate Complex located at 10608 Paul Buckman Highway. Plant City, Hillsborough County. This permit is for a modification to decrease the minimum pond water pressure to the fume scrubbers for the X, Y, and Z-Train Granulation Units.

The applicant's mailting address is: P.O. Drawer I. Plant City, Florida 33564. A Best Available Control Technology (BACT) determination was not required pursuant to Rule 62-212, 400, F.A.C. and 40 CFR 52.21. Prevention of Significant Deterioration (PSD).

The Department will issue the Final permit modification unless a response received in accordance with the following procedures results in a different decision, or significant change of terms or conditions.

The Department will accept written comments concerning the proposed permit modification issuance action for a period of fourteen (14) days from the date of publication of this Public Notice of Intent to Issue Air Modification Permit. Written comments should be provided to the Department's Bureau of Air Regulation at 2600 Blair Stone Road, Mail Station #5505, Tallahassee, FL 32399-2400. Any written comments filed shall be made available for public inspection. If written comments received result in a significant change in the proposed agency action, the Department shall revise the proposed permit and require, if applicable, another Public Notice.

The Department will issue the permit with the attached conditions unless a timely petition for an administrative hearing is filed pursuant to sections 120.559 and 120.57 F.S., before the deadline for liling a petition. The procedures for petitioning for a hearing are set forth below.

Mediation is not available in this proceeding.

substantial interests are affected by the proposed permitting decision may petition for an administrative proceeding (hearing) under sections 120.569 and 120.57 of the Florida Statutes. The petition must contain the information set forth below and must be filed (received) in the Office of General Counsel of the Department at 3900 C o m m o n w e a l t h Boulevard, Mail Station #35, Tallahassee, Florida, 32399-3000. Petitions filed by the permit applicant or any of the parties! listed below must be filed within, fourteen days of receipt of this notice of intent. Petitions filed by any persons other than those entitled to written notice under section 120.60(3) of the Florida Statutes must be filed within fourteen days of publication of the public notice or within fourteen days of publication of the public notice of intent. Whichever occurs first. Under section 120.60(3), however, any person who asked the Department for notice of agency action may file a petition within fourteen days of receipt of that notice, regardless of the date of publication. A petitioner shall mail a copy of the petition to the applicant at the address indicated above at the time of filing. The failure of any person to file a petition within fourteen shall mail a copy of the petition to the applicant at the address indicated above at the time of filing. The failure of any person's right to request an administrative determination (hearing) under sections 120.569 and 120.57 Fs., or to intervene in this proceeding and participate as a party to it. Any subsequent intervention will be only at the approval of the presiding officer upon the filing of a motion in compliance with Ryle f28-106.205 of the Florida Administrative code.

A petition that disputes the material facts on which the Department's action, is based must contain the following information: (a) The name and address of each agency affected and each agency's file or identification number, if known; (b) The name, address and telephone number of the petitioner, the name, address, and telephone number of the pe t i t i o n e r's representative, if any, which shall, be the address for service purposes during the course of the proceeding; and an explanation of how the petitioner's substantial interests will, be affected by the agency determination; (c) A statement of how and when petitioner received, notice of the agency action or proposed action; (d) A statement of all disputed issues of material fact. If there are none, the petitioner contends warrant reversal or modification of the agency's proposed action; (f) A statement of the petitioner contends warrant reversal or modification of the agency's proposed action; and (g) A statement of the specific rules or statutes the petitioner, stating precisely the action petitioner wishes the agency to take with respect to the agency's proposed action; be agency to take with respect to the agency's proposed action.

A petition that does not dispute the material facts upon which the Department's action is based shall state that no such facts are in dispute and otherwise shall contain the same information as set forth above, as required by rule 28106.301.

Be cause the administrative hearing process is designed to formulate final agency action, the filing of a petition means that the bepartment's final action may be different from the position taken by it in this notice. Persons whose substantial interests will be affected by any such, final decision of the Department on the application have the right to petition to become a party to the proceeding, in accordance with the requirements set forth above.
