The Department of Environmental Regulation hereby gives notice of its intent to gives notice of its intent to Issue a modified permit to CF Industries, Inc., Post Office Drower L, Plant City, FL 33564, for the existing mothen sulfur storage and handling system for an increase in maiten sulfur annual throughput to 930,750 tons located at CFI's facility in Plant City, Hillsborough County, Florida, A determination of the Best Available

Control Technology (BACT) was not required. The Depart-ment is issuing this Intent to Issue for the reasons stated in the revised Technical Evaluation and Preliminary Determination

A person whose substantial interests are affected by the Department's proposed permitting decision may petition for an administrative pro-ceeding (hearing) in accordance with Section 120.57, Florida Statutes. The petition must contain the information set forth below and must be filed (received) in the Office of General Counsel of the De-partment at 2600 Blair Stone Road, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-2400, within fourteen (14) days of publication of this notice. Petitioner shall mail a copy of the petition to the applicant at the address indicated above at the time of filling. Fallure to file a petition within this time period shall constitute a waiver of any right such person may have to request an administrative determination (hearing) under Section 120.57, Florida Stat-

The petition shall contain the following information:

(a) The name, address, and telephone number of each petitioner, the applicant's name and address, the Department Permit File Number and the county in which the project is proposed:

(b) A statement of how and when each petitioner received notice of the Department's action or proposed action:

(c) A statement of how each petitioner's substantial interests are affected by the Department's action or proposed

(d) A statement of the material facts disputed by Petitioner, if any;

(e) A statement of facts which petitioner contends warrant reversal or modification of the Department's action or proposed action;

(f) A statement of which rules or statutes petitioner contends require reversal or modification of the Department's action or proposed action; and

(g) A statement of the relief sought by petitioner, stating precisely the action petitioner wants the Department to take with respect to the Depart-ment's action or proposed ac-
