As I stated in today's conference call, we have numerous concerns about Mosaic's proposed modifications on all their SAPs at the Riverview facility, since this is one of the biggest sources in the County. We look forward to working with your office, the District and Mosaic in resolving these issues and addressing our concerns. However, in addition to our concerns relating to Mosaic's proposed modifications, we believe that Mosaic is not exempt from BART as they did not submit their BART exemption request by January 31, 2007 as required by Rule 62-296.340(5)(d), F.A.C.
