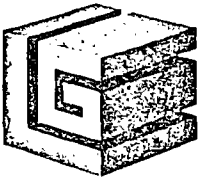

In response to Condition 4 of Permit AC29-21345 for upgrading our No. 3 Phosphoric Acid Plant, Gardiner has permanently removed the below listed units from operation and relinquishes all permits pertaining thereto:

- a. Normal Superphosphate Plant (A029-13812)
- b. No. 2 Phosphoric Acid Plant (A029-6865)
- c. No. 6, 7, and 8 Rock Grinding Mills (A029-22139)
- d. 68 BPL Rock Unloading and Storage Airslides (A029-22142)
- e. North No. 2 and 3 Rock Transfer Airslides (A029-13212)
- f. South No. 2 and 3 Rock Transfer Airslides (A029-6864)
- g. Center No. 3 Rock Transfer Airslide (A029-13212)
- h. No. 3 Rock Transfer Airslide Bin (A029-13212)
- i. No. 2 and 3 Filter Buildings (A0-12609 and A029-13544)
- j. No. 10, 11, and 12 Rock Grinding Mills (A029-22141 and A029-22140)

The #3 Phosphoric Acid Plant was removed from service on May 13, 1983 and it appears at this time that there will be no problem in completion of construction by January 1, 1984 and submission of an application for an operating permit by March 1, 1984.

You will be kept informed if circumstances change this schedule.
