The permitting authority will accept written comments concerning the proposed Title V DRAFT Permit issuance oction for a period of 30 (thirly) days from the date of publication of this Notice. Written comments should be provided to the Department's Bureau of Air Regulation, 2600 Bloir Stone Road, Mail Station #5505, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-2400, Any written comments filed shall be made available for public inspection. if written comments received result in a significant change in this DRAFT Permit, the permitting authority shall is-sue a Révised DRAFT Permit and require, if applicable, another Public Notice.

A person whose substantial interests are affected by the proposed permitting decision may petition for an administrative hearing in accordance with Sections 120.569 and 120.57 of the Florida Statutes (F.S.). The petition must contain the information set forth below and must be filed (received) in the Office of Gener al Counsel of the Department of Environmental Protection, 3900 Commonwealth Boulevard, Mall Station #35, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-3000 (Telephone: 850/488-9730; Fax: 850/487-4938). Petitions filed by any persons other than those entitled to written notice under Section 120,60(3), F.S., must be filed within fourteen days of publication of the public notice or within fourteen days of receipt of the notice of intent, whichever occurs first. Under Section 120.60(3), F.S., however, any person who asked the permitting authority for notice of agency action may file a petition within tourteen days of receipt of that notice, regardless of the date of publication. A petitioner shall mall a copy of the petition to the applicant at the address indicated obover of the time of filing. The failure of any person to file a petition within the applicable time period shall consti**tute a** walver of that person's right to request an administrative determination (hearing) under Sections 120.569 and 120.57, F.S., or to intervene In this proceeding and participute as a party to it. Any subsequent intervention will be only at the approval of the presiding officer upon the fil-Ing of a mation in compliance with Rule 28-106.205 of the Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.).

A petition that disputes the material facts on which the permitting authority's action is based must contain the following information:

(a) The name and address of each agency affected and each agency's file or identification number, it known:

(b) The name, address and telephone number of the petitioner; name address and telephone number of the petitioner's representative, if any, which shall be the address for service purposes during the course of the proceeding; and an explanation of how petitioner's substantial rights will be affected by the agency determination:

(c) A statement or how and when the petitioner received notice of the agency action or proposed action;

(d) A statement of all disputed issues of material fact. If there are none, the petition must so state:

(e) A concise statement of the ultimate facts alleged, as well as the rules and statutes which entitle petitioner to relief:

(f) A statement of the specific rules or statutes the petitioner contends require reversal or modification of the agency's proposed action; and,

(g) A statement of the relief sought by the petitioner, stating precisely the action pettioner wishes the ogency to take with respect to the ogency's proposed action.

A petition that does not dispute the moterial facts upon which the permitting outhority's action is based shall state that no such facts are in dispute and otherwise shall contain the same information as set forth above, as required by Rule 28-106.301, F.A.C.

in addition to the above, pursuant to 42 United States Code (U.S.C.)
