
## EARLY NOTICE AND PUBLIC REVIEW OF A PROPOSED **ACTIVITY IN A 100-YEAR FLOODPLAIN**

To: All interested Agencies, Groups and Individuals

This is to give notice that Hillsborough County under Part 58 has conducted an evaluation as required by Executive Order 11988, in accordance with HUD regulations at 24 CFR 55:20 Subpart C Procedures for Making Determinations on Floodplain Management, to determine the potential affect that its activity in the floodplain will have on the human environment. The proposed project is located at 1702 Waller Street, Plant City, Hillsborough County. The scope of the project is to remediate for refuse, provide protection from any recognized environmental conditions, and provide improvements to Snowden Park Project under a program

funded through the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development, Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program. Activities will include clearance, rehabilitation and improvements to public facilities at an existing public park. Facilities are in place and will not be changed in size or capacity more than 20 percent and the land use will not change. Sub-activities include site investigation, field & laboratory analyses, developing a site specific remedial action plan, and applying engineering (two feet of clean soil), and institutional controls to rehabilitate the property. Various site amenities (may include landscaping, lighting and additional athletic improvements) will be added to the park upon completion of rehabilitation. The purpose of this project is to provide park facilities 'o the residents of the local low income neighborhood. The size of proposed project is approximately five acres and is 100 percent in flood zone AE.

There are three primary purposes for this notice. First, people who may be affected by activities in floodplains and those who have an interest in the

protection of the natural environment should be given an opportunity to express their concerns and provide information about these areas. Second, an adequate public notice program can be an important public educational tool. The dissemination of information about floodplains can facilitate and enhance Federal efforts to reduce the risks associated with the occupancy and modification of these special areas. Third, as a matter of fairness, when the Federal government determines it will participate in actions taking place in floodplains, it must inform those who may be put at greater or continued risk.
