Thank you for the Department letter dated October 31, 2005, regarding additional information on our request for facility name change from "Covanta Lake, Inc." to "Covanta Lake II, Inc." It appears that the additional information was determined based on the requirements for a Transfer of Air Permits.

Covanta Lake wishes to clarify that it is NOT requesting for a Transfer of Air Permits - the submitted documents was a request for a name change. In the absent of a form for name change, Covanta Lake altered the heading on page 2 of the Application for Transfer of Air Permit. 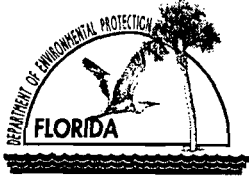

Please provide documentation that you meet the definition criteria at Rule 62-210.200, F.A.C., Definitions – Responsible Official, for both corporations and that you are an Authorized Representative for both, or have the form(s) signed by the appropriate person(s). Until this documentation has been received, then the application is not processable. The Forms and Instruction for the "Responsible Official Notification Form", effective 6-2-02, are established at Rule 62-213.900(8), F.A.C.
2. Even though not due immediately, a Statement of Compliance for the affected Title V facility, signed by the R.O., must be submitted by no later than December 24, 2005, close of business; and, the Statement of Compliance must cover the timeframe of January 1 through October 25, 2005.
