Dear Mr. Garcia:

On May 15, 2009 the Department received your application for a Title V renewal permit for the Stock Island Power Plant. The application is incomplete. In order to continue processing your application, the Department will need the additional information requested below pursuant to Rule 62-213.420(1)(b)3., F.A.C., and Rule 62-4.070(1), F.A.C. Should your response to any of the items below require new calculations, please submit the new calculations, assumptions, reference material and appropriate revised pages of the application form.

- 1. Please submit the following additional requirements for a Title V renewal application which did not appear to have been submitted:
 - a. Facility Plot Plan,
 - b. Process Flow Diagram,
 - c. Precautions to Prevent Emissions of Unconfined Particulate Matter,
 - d. List of Insignificant Activities,
 - e. Identification of Applicable Requirements, and
 - f. Verification of Risk Management Plan Submission to EPA.
- 2. As appropriate for each emission unit, please provide the following additional requirements for a Title V renewal application which did not appear to have been submitted:
 - a. Process Flow Diagram,
 - b. Fuel Analysis or Specification,
 - c. Detailed Description of Control Equipment,
 - d. Procedures for Startup and Shutdown,
 - e. Operation and Maintenance Plan, and
 - f. Emission Unit Specific Applicable Requirements.
- 3. Please specify whether or not a selective catalytic reduction unit is installed for EU011.
- 4. The Acid Rain Part Application submitted with the application listed only one unit. The facility's Title V permit no. 0870003-008-AV identified four emissions units regulated under the Acid Rain Program. The referenced Title V permit included a retired unit and two (2) new unit exemptions. Please re-evaluate the facility's emission units subject to the acid rain program. Please re-submit the Acid Rain Part Application, if necessary, including the new unit exemption forms and the retired unit exemption form.

- 5. Please specify if any of the facility's generators or other emissions units are subject to 40 CFR 60 Subpart IIII, Standards of performance for Stationary Compression Ignition (CI) Internal Combustion Engines (ICE), 40 CFR 63 Subpart ZZZZ, National Emission Standards for Hazardous Air Pollutants for Stationary Reciprocating Internal Combustion Engines, or 40 CFR 60 Subpart JJJJ, Standards of Performance for Stationary Spark Ignition (SI) Internal Combustion Engines. If applicable,
 - a. Please specify how the facility is complying with the applicable subpart(s).
 - b. Please provide the following information for each emission unit subject to the referenced subparts: in-service date, cylinder displacement, and rule applicability.

Responsible Official (R.O.) Certification Statement: Rule 62-213.420, F.A.C. requires that all Title V permit applications must be certified by a responsible official. Due to the nature of the information requested in Item number(s) 1, 2, and 4 above, your response should be certified by the responsible official. Please complete and submit a new R.O. certification statement page from the long application form, DEP Form No. 62-210.900(1), effective March 16, 2008.

<u>Professional Engineer (P.E.) Certification Statement:</u> Rule 62-4.050(3), F.A.C. requires that all applications for a Department permit must be certified by a professional engineer registered in the State of Florida. This requirement also applies to responses to Department requests for additional information of an engineering nature. As a result, at a minimum your response to Item number(s) 1, 2, 4, and 5 above should be certified by a professional engineer registered in the State of Florida. Please complete and submit a new P.E. certification statement page from the long application form, DEP Form No. 62-210.900(1), effective March 16, 2008.

The Department must receive a response from you within 90 (ninety) days of receipt of this letter, unless you (the applicant) request additional time under Rule 62-213.420(1)(b)5., F.A.C. In order to ensure that your acid rain permit is effective by January 1, 2010, you are highly encouraged to respond to this request as soon as possible.
