DRAFT Title V Major Source Air Operation Permit No. 0870003-006-AV Stock Island Power Plant Monroe County

Applicant: The applicant for this project is Keys Energy Services, 1001 James Street, P.O. Box 6100, Key West. Florida 33041-6100. The applicant's responsible official is Mr. Daniel Cassel, Director of Generation.

Facility Location: The applicant operates a nominal 80.7 MW Power Plant, which is located at 6900 Front Street, Stock Island, Monroe County, Florida.

Project: The applicant submitted an application for a Title V Air Operation Permit (Permit). The facility consists of five regulated emission units with a total generating capacity of 80.7 MW. There are two regulated diesel generators, three simple cycle combustion turbines, and miscellaneous unregulated units. To reduce politulion, a combination of control techniques is used including water injection, ignition timing retardation, and low sulfur fuel oil. The Ratiph Garcia Steam Plant (EPA ID #1] was retired January 1, 1998. Also included in this permit are insignificant emissions units and activities. This permit will be a Title V Air Operation Permit Renewal to initial Title V Operation Permit issued in 1999 as revised in 2002. The main change compared with the present permit relates to the identification of Retired and New Unit Exemption emission units. The change was considered insignificant. Emissions from this facility will not be increased as a result of this project.

Permitting Authority: Applications for Title V major source air operation permits are subject to review in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 403, Florida Statutes (F.S.) and Chapters 62-4, 62-210, 62-213 and 62-214 of the Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.). The proposed project is not exempt from air permitting requirements and an air permit is required to operate the facility. The Department of Environmental Protection, Bureau of Air Regulation is the Permitting Authority responsible for making a permit determination regarding this project. The Permitting Authority's physical address is: Florida Department of Environmental Protection, Bureau of Air Regulation, 111 South Magnotia Drive, Suite 4, Tallahassee, Florida 23301. Project File: A complete project file is available for public inspection during the normal business hours of 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday (except legal holidays), at address indicated above for the Permitting Authority. The complete project file includes the Draft Permit, the Statement of Basis, the application, and the indom ration submitted by the applicant, exclusive of confidential records under Section 403.111, F.S. Interested persons may view the DRAFT Permit and file electronic comments by visiting the following websate: http://www.dep.state.fl.us/atr/eproducts/ards/. A copy of the complete project file is also available at the File Comment of Environmental Protection, Southwest District Office, 3804 Coconut Palm Drive, Tampa, Political 33619-1352, Tetechone: 813744-8100.

Notice of Intent to Issue Air Permit: The Permitting Authority gives notice of its intent to issue a permit to the applicant for the project described above. The applicant has provided reasonable assurance that operation of the facility with not adversely impact air quality and that the project will comply with all appropriate provisions of Chapters 82-4, 62-204, 62-210, 62-212, 62-213, 62-256, 62-257, 62-281, 62-296, and 62-297, FALC. The Permitting Authority will issue a PROPOSED Permit and subsequent FINAL Permit in accordance with the conditions of the DRAFT Permit unless a response received in accordance with the following procedures results in a different decision or a significant change of terms or conditions.

Comments: The Permitting Authority will accept written comments concerning the DRAFT Permit renewal for a period of thiny (30) days from the date of publication of this Public Notice. Written comments must be post-marked and all e-mail or facsimile comments must be received by the close of business (5 pm) on or before the end of this 30-day period by the Permitting Authority at the above address, e-mail or facsimile. As part of his or her comments, any person may also request that the Permitting Authority hold a public meeting on this permitting action. If the Permitting Authority determines there is sufficient interest for a public meeting, it will publish notice of the time, date, and location on the Department's official web site for notices (http://tihore6.dep.state.fl.us/onw/) and in a newspaper of general circulation in the area affected by the permitting action. For additional information, contact the Permitting Authority at the above address or phone number. If written comments or comments received at a public meeting result in a significant change to the DRAFT Permit, the Permitting Authority shall revise the DRAFT Permit and require. If apolicable, another Public Notice. All comments filed will be made available for public inspection.

Petitions: A person whose substantial interests are affected by the proposed permitting decision may petition for an administrative hearing in accordance with Sections 120.559 and 120.57, F.S. The petition must contain the information set forth below and must be filled with (received by) the Department's Agency Clerk in the Office of General Counsel of the Department of Environmental Protection at 3900 Commonwealth Boulevard, Mail Station 835, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-3000. Petitions filled by any persons other than those entitled to written notice under Section 120.60(3), F.S. must be filled within fourtheen (14) days of publication of this Public Notice or receipt of a written notice, whichever occurs first. Under Section 120.60(3), F.S., however, any person who asked the Permitting Authority for notice of spency action may file a petition within fourteen (14) days of receipt of that notice, regardless of the date of publication. A petitioner shall mell a copy of the petition to the applicant at the address indicated above, at the time of filing. The fathers of any person to file a petition within the appropriate time period shall constitute a welver of that person's right to request an administrative determination (hearing) under Sections 120.559 and 120.57, F.S., or to intervene in this proceeding and peritipate as a party to ft. Any obsequent intervention will be only at the approval of the presiding officer upon the filing of a motion in compliance with Rule 28-

A petition that disputes the material facts on which the Permitting Authority's action is based must contain the following information: (a) The name and address of each agency affected and each agency's file or identification number, if known; (b) The name, address and telephone number of the petitioner's representative, if any, which shall be the address for service purposes during the course of the proceeding; and an explanation of how the petitioner's substantial rights will be affected by the agency determination; (c) A statement of how and when the petitioner's substantial rights will be affected by the agency determination; (c) A statement of all disputed issues of material fact. If there are none, the petition must so state; (e) A concise statement of the ultimate facts alleged, including the specific facts the petitioner contends warrant reversal or modification of the agency's proposed action; (f) A statement of the specific rules or statutes the petitioner contends require reversal or modification of the agency's proposed action; and, (g) A statement of the reller ought by the petitioner, stating precisely the action the petitioner wishes the agency to take with respect to the agency's proposed action. A petition that does not dispute the material facts upon which the Permitting Authority's action is based shall state that no such facts are in dispute and otherwise shall contain the same information as set forth above, as required by Rule 28-106.301, F.A.C.

Because the administrative hearing process is designed to formulate final agency action, the filing of a petition means that the Permitting Authority's final action may be different from the position taken by it in this Public Notice of intern. Persons whose substantial interests will be affected by any such final decision of the Permitting Authority on the application have the right to petition to become a party to the proceeding, in accordance with the requirements set both above.

Mediation: Mediation is not available for this proceeding.

Objections: In addition to the above right to petition, pursuant to 42 United States Code (U.S.C.) Section 7861d(b)(2), any person may petition the Administrator of the EPA within sixty (60) days of the expiration of the Administrator's 45 (forty-five) day review period as established at 42 U.S.C. Section 7661d(b)(1), to object to the issuance of any Title V major source air operation permit. Any petition shall be based only on objections to the permit that were raised with reasonable specificity during the thirty (30) day public comment period provided in the Public Notice, unless the petitioner demonstrates to the Administrator of the EPA that it was impracticable to raise such objections within the comment period or unless the grounds for such objection arcee after the comment period. Filling of a petition with the Administrator of the EPA does not stay the effective date of any permit properly issued pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 62-213, F.A.C. Petitions filed with the Administrator of EPA must meet the requirements of 42 U.S.C. Section 7861d(b)(2) and must be filed with the Administrator of the EPA at: U.S. EPA, 401 M Street, S.W., Washington, D.C. 20460.
