Applicant: The applicant for this project is Walt Disney World Company, P.O. Box 10,000. Lake Buena Vista FL 3283-1000. The applicant's responsible official is Mr. Lee Schmudde, Vice President.

Facility Location: The applicant operates the Walt Disney World Resort Complex, which is located at 1375 Buena Vista Drive, Lake Buena Vista, Orange and Osceola Counties, Florida.

Project: The applicant submitted an application for a Title V Air Operation Permit Renewal.

The facility is a complex of notels, theme parks and support facilities, and a utility. The various air pollution sources are boilers, a combined cycle combustion turbine with a natural gas-fired heaf recovery steam generator, paint spray booths and associated operations, external combustion (thermal) oil hedters and hot water heaters.

Permitting Authority: Applications for Title V air operation permits are subject to review in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 403, Florida Stoutes (F.S.) and Chapters 62-4, 62-21), 62-213, and 62-214 of the Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.). The proposed project is not exempt from air permitting requirements and an air permit is required to operate the facility. The Department of Environmental Protection, Bureau of Air Regulation, is the Permitting Authority responsible for making a permit determination regarding this project. The Permitting Authority gives notice of its intent to issue a permit to the applicant for the project described above. The applicant has provided reasonable assurance that operation of the facility will not adversely impact air quality and that the project will comply with all appropriate provisions of Chapters 62-4, 62-204, 62-210, 62-212, 62-313, 62-314, 62-395, and 62-397, each more than a FINAL Permit in accordance with the conditions of the DRAFT/PROPOSED Permit "unless a response received in accordance with the following procedures results in a different decision or a significant change of terms or conditions.

Petitions filed by any persons other than those entitled to written notice under Section 120.60(3), F.S. must be filed within fourteen (14) days of publication of this Public Notice or receipt of a written notice, whichever occurs first. Under Section 120.60(3), F.S., however, any person who asked the Permitting Authority for notice of agency action may file a petition within fourteen (14) days of receipt of that notice, regardless of the date of publication. A petitioner shall mail a copy of the petition within fourteen (14) days of receipt of a written notice, regardless of the date of publication. A petition that does not dispute the material facts upon which the Per-mitting Authority's action is based shall state that no such facts are in dispute and otherwise shall contain the same information as set forth above, as required by Rule 28-106.301, F.A.C.

Because the administrative hearing process is designed to formulate final agency action, the filing of a petition means that the Permitting Authority's final action may be different from the position taken by it in this Public Notice of Intent. Persons whose substantial interests will be affected by any such final decision of the Permitting Authority on the application have the right to petition to become a party to the proceeding, in accordance with the requirements set forth above.

Mediation: Mediation is not available for this proceeding.

EPA Review & Objections: EPA has agreed to freat the DRAFT Title V Permit as a PROPOSED Title V Permit and to perform its 35-day review provided by the low and regulations concurrently with the public comment period. Although EPA's 45-day review period will be performed concurrently with the public comment period, the deadline for submitting a citizen petition to object to the EPA Administrator will be determined as if EPA's 45-day review period is performed after the public comment period has ended. The FINAL Title V Air Operation Permit will be issued after the conclusion of the 45-day EPA review period so long as no adverse comments are received that results in a different decision or significant change of terms or conditions.
