Applicant: The applicant for this project is Progress Energy Florida, 6525 Osceola-Polk County Line Road, Interces-sion City, Florida 33848. The applicant's responsible offi-cial is Ms. Julie Turner.

Project: On July 5, 2007 the applicant applied to the Permitting Authority for a Title V Air Operation Permit Renewal. This facility is a nominal 1057 megawatts (NW) power plant that consists of fourteen simple cycle intermittent duty combustion turbines (CT). All of the CT are considered to be peaking units that are used primarily during periods of greatest daily or seasonal demand. Further details of the project are provided in the application and the enclosed "Statement of Basis".

Permitting Authority: Applications for processing Title V Air Operation permits are subject to review in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 403. Florida Statutes (F. S.) and Chapters 62-4, 62-210, 62-212, 62-213 and 62-214 of the Florida Administrative Code (F. A. C.). The proposed project is not exempt from air permitting requirements and an air permit is required to operate the facility in the manner requested. The Department of Environmental Protection. Bureau of Air Regulation is the Permitting Authority responsible for making a permit determination regarding this project. Notice of Intent to Issue a Permit: The Permitting Authority gives notice of its intent to issue a permit to the applicant for the project described above. The applicant has provided reasonable assurance that operation of the facility will not adversely impact air auality and that the project will comply with all appropriate provisions of Chapters 62, 62-210, 62-212, 62-213, 62-214, 62-296, and 62-297, F.A.C. The Permitting Authority will issue a FINAL Permit in accordance with the conditions of the DRAFT/PROPOSED Permit unless a response received in accordance with the tollowing procedures results in a different decision or a significant change of terms or conditions.

Comments: The Permitting Authority will accept written comments concerning the DRAFT/PROPOSED Permit for a period of thirty (30) days from the date of publication of this Public Notice. Written comments must be post-marked and all e-mail or facsimile comments must be received by the close of business (5 pm) on or before the end of this 30-day period by the Permitting Authority at the above address, email or facsimile. As part of his or her comments, any person may also request that the Permitting Authority hold a public meeting on this permitting authority hold a public meeting on this permitting action. If the Permitting Authority determines there is sufficient interest for a public meeting, it will publish notice of the time, date, and location on the Florida Administrative Weekly (FAW) website at http://aw.dos.state.tus and in a newspaper of general circulation in the area affected by the permitting action. Mediation: Mediation is not available for this proceeding.

PA Review & Objections: EPA has agreed to treat the DRAFT Title V Permit as a PROPOSED Title V Permit and to perform its 45-day review provided by the low and regulations concurrently with the public comment period. Although EPA's 45-day review period will be performed concurrently with the public comment period, the dead-line for submitting a citizen petition to object to the EPA Administrator will be determined as if EPA's 45-day review period is performed after the public comment period has ended. The FINAL Title V Air Operation Permit will be issued after the conclusion of the 45-day EPA review period so long as no adverse comments are received that results in a different decision or significant change of terms or conditions.

Finally, pursuant to 42 United States Code (U.S.C.) Section 7661d(b)(2), any person may petition the Administrator of the EPA within Sixty (80) days of the expiration of the Administrator's 45 (forty-five) day review period as established at 42 U.S.C. Section 7661d(b)(1), to object to the Issuance of any Title V air operation permit. Any petition shall be based only on objections to the Permit that were raised with reasonable specificity during the thirty (30) day public comment period provided in the Public Notice, unless the petitioner demonstrates to the Administrator of the EPA that it was impracticable to raise such objections within the comment period or unless the strong of such objection arose after the comment period. Filing of a petition with the Administrator of the EPA does not stay the effective date of any permit properly issued pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 62-213, F.A.C. Petitions filed with the Administrator of EPA must meet the requirements of 42 U.S.C. Section 7661d(b)(2) and must be filed with the Administrator of the EPA at U.S. EPA, 401 M Street, S.W., Washington, D.C. 20460.
