The Department of Environmental Protection (permitting authority) gives notice of its intent to Issue a Title V Air Operation Permit to Reliant Energy Osceola, L.L.C. for the Reliant Energy Osceola, L.L.C. facility, located at 5200 West Holopaw Road, St. Cloud, Osceola County. The permitting authority will issue the PROPOSED Permit and subsequent FI. NAL Permit, in accordance with the conditions of the DRAFT Permit unless a response received in accordance with the following procedures results in a different decision or significant change of terms or conditions.

The permitting authority will accept written comments concerning the proposed DRAFT Permit issuance action for a period of 30 (thirty) days from the date of publication of this Notice. Written comments should be provided to the permitting authority's office at Bureau of Air Regulation, 2600 Blair Stone Road, Mail Station #5055, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-2400. Any written comments filed shall be made available for public inspection. If written comments received result in a significant change in this DRAFT Permit, the permitting authority shall issue a Revised DRAFT Permit and require, if applicable, another public authority shall issue a

Petitions filed by any persons other than those enti-tled to written notice under Section 120.60(3), F.S., must be filed within fourteen days of publication of the public days of receipt of the notice of intent, whichever occurs first. Under Section 120.60(3), F.S., however any person who asked the per-mitting authority for notice of agency action may file a petition within fourteen days of receipt of that notice, regardless of the date of publication. A petitioner shall mail a copy of the petition to the applicant at the address indicated above, at the time of filing. The failure of any person to file a petition within the applicable time period shall constitute a waiver of that person's right to request an administrative determina-tion (hearing) under Sections 120.569 and 120.57, F.S. or to the intervene in this proceeding and participate as a party to it. Any subseay a parry to 17. Any subsequent intervention will be only at the approval of the presiding officer upon the filling of a motion in compliance with Rule 28-106.205,

A petition that disputes the material facts on which the permitting authority's action is based must contain the following information:

(a) The name and address of each agency affected and each agency affected and each agency's file or identification number, if known;
(b) The name, address and telephone number of the petallians agency address and telephone number of the petallicans.

(c) A statement of how and when the petitioner received notice of the agency action or proposed action;

(d) A statement of all dis-puted issues of material fact. If there are none, the petition must so state;

(e) A concise statement of the ultimate facts alleged, as well as the rules and stat-utes which entitle petitioner to relief;

(f) A statement of the specific rules or statutes the petition contends, require reversal or modification of the agency's proposed action;

(g) A statement of the relief sought by the petitioner, stating precisely the action petitioner wishes the agency to take with respect to the agency's proposed action.

A petition that does not dispute the materia facts upon which the permitting au-thority's action is based shall state that no such facts are in dispute and otherwise shall contain the same infor-mation as set forth above, as required by Rule 28-106.301, F.A.C. Because the administrative

hearing process is designed to formulate final agency action, the filing of a peti-tion means that the permitting authority's final action may be different from the position taken by it in this notice of intent. Persons whose substantial interests will be affected by any such final decision of the permittinal decision of the permiting authority on the appli-cation have the right to petition to become a party to the proceeding, in accor-dance with the require-ments set forth above.

Mediation is not available for this proceeding.
In addition to the above, pursuant to 42 United States Code (U.S.C.) Section 7661d(b)(2) any person may petition the Administrator of the EPA within 60 (sixty) of the EPA within 60 (sixty) days of the expiration of the Administrator's 45 (forty-five) day review period as established at 42 U.S.C. Section 7661d(b)(1), to object to issuance of any permit. Any petition shall be based only on objections to the permit that were raised with reasonable specificity during the 30(thirty) day public comment period provided in comment period provided in this notice, unless the peti-tion demonstrates to the Administrator of the EPA that it was impracticable to raise such objections within the comment period or un-less the grounds for such objection arose after the com-ment period. Filing of a petition with the Adminis-trator of the EPA does not stay the effective date of any permit properly issued pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 62-213, F.A.C. Peti-Chapter 62-213, F.A.C. Petitions filled with the Administrator of EPA must meet the requirements of 42 U.S.C. Section 7661d(b)(2) and must be filled with the Administrator of the EPA of U.S.C. Sepa, 401 M. Street, S.W., Washington, D.C. 20460 20460.
