

Palm Beach County The Department of Environ-mental Protection (Depart-ment) gives notice of its intent to-issue an air construction permit modification to Solid permit modification to Solid Waste Authority of Palm Beach County, to modify an existing construction permit for the North County Resource Recovery Facility located at 7501 North Jog Road, West Palm Beach, Palm Beach County. This permitting action will supersede the previous permit modification, 750-FL-106(8), dated February 20. 108(8), dated February 20, 1996, clerked February 21, 1996. The permit modification is to allow for an upgrade of the blower motors for each landfill gas flare from a per-mitted flow rate of 900 acfm to a permitted flow rate of 1800 scfm. This permit modifi-cation will clarify previous permit conditions and remove a limitation on the sulfur content imitation on the sulfur content of the landfill gas, which the applicant cannot control. The landfill flares are used to

comply with federal regula-tions for control of landfill gas and the proposed project necessary for compliance with the federal requirements. The proposed project does not re-suit in net emissions increases that are significant for the Prethat are significant for the Pre-vention of Significant Deterio-ration program. Emissions in-creases will occur primarily for nitrogen oxides, carbon monoxide and sulfur dioxide. An air quality impact analysis was not required. The Department will issue the Final permit modification with the attached conditions unless.

decision or significant change of terms or conditions. The Department will accept written comments and re-quests for public meetings concerning the proposed per-mit issuance action for a per-od of 30 (thirty) days from the date of publication of this Pub-lic Notice of Intent to Issue Air Construction Permit.
