Scott,

After reviewing the attached change to the PROPOSED Title V Permit, Solid Waste Authority's comments are as follows:

- 1). Instead of adding a new section (b) for (2) Unauthorized Fuel, SWA is suggesting that the two items in section (b) concerning the matter of biomedical/biological wastes be combined with section 2(a) and be renumbered as (10) & (11). SWA is also recommending that the language "shall not knowingly burn:" be used in section (a) for all wastes listed in this section.
- 2). It is SWA's understanding that Item (2) (a) (9) beryllium-containing waste, as defined in 40 CFR 61, Subpart C was not applicable and not going to be included in the permit. However, if this item is kept, SWA is asking that a footnote be added to the permit which references EPA's determination letter dated April 6, 2000 regarding the applicability of the emission standard 40 CFR 61, Subpart C to MSW's.

I will call you on Friday, June 2nd, as a follow-up to this email.
