If a public meeting is requested within the 30-day comment period and conducted by the Permitting Authority, any oral and written comments received during the public meeting will also be considered by the Permitting Authority, any oral and written comments received at a public meeting result in a significant change to the draft/proposed permit revision and require, if applicable, another Public Notice.
