Dear Mr. Booth:

On September 16 & 19, the department received your response. As part of your response you provided the requested updated applicable requirements. In order to further define applicability of the NSPS Subpart WWW and the NESHAP Subpart AAAA to the landfills we need the following additional information:

1. Does either landfill have a bioreactor?
2. What is the design capacity in megagrams of each landfill?
3. When did each landfill commence construction? Has each landfill been modified? Please provide the dates in years for major modifications.
4. When did each landfill start to receive waste, the year?
5. What is the yearly waste acceptance, in megagrams?
6. Are the NMOC emissions less than, equal to, or greater than 50 megagrams/year?
7. Is each landfill a major source of HAP's?
8. Has either landfill ever been an active asbestos waste disposal site?
9. When did the collection and control of landfill gases begin?
10. When is each landfill expected to close?



of its intent to issue a Title V
Air Operation Permit
Renewal and an Air Con-
struction Permit to the Solid
Waste Authority of Palm
Beach County, located at

Palm Beach, Palm Beach
County. The applicant's

The applicant applied to the
permitting authority for a
Title V Air Operation Permit
Renewal and for an after-
the-fact Air Construction
Permit for the woody waste
facility diesel engine. The
engine is an unregulated
emissions unit.
The permitting authority will
issue the Air Construction
Permit and the PRO-
POSED Title V Air Opera-
tion Permit Renewal and
subsequent FINAL Title Air
Operation Permit Renewal,
in accordance with the con-
ditions of the Draft Air Con-
struction Permit and the
DRAFT Title V Air Opera-
tion Permit Renewal unless
a response received in
accordance with the follow-
ing procedures results in a
different decision or signifi-
cant change of terms or
conditions.
The permitting authority will
accept written comments
concerning the proposed
Draft Air Construction Per-
mit issuance action for a
period of 14 (fourteen) days
from the date of publication
of this Public Notice. Writ-
ten comments should be
provided to the Depart-
ment's Bureau of Air Regu-
lation, 2600 Blair Stone
Road, Mail Station #5505,
Tallahassee, Florida 32399-
2400. Any written com-
ments filed shall be made
available for public inspec-
tion. If written comments
received result in a signifi-
cant change in the Draft
Construction Permit, the
permitting authority shall
issue a Revised Draft Air
Construction Permit and re-
quire, if applicable, another
Public Notice.
The permitting authority will
accept written comments
concerning the DRAFT Title
V Air Operation Permit
Renewal for a period of
thirty (30) days from the
date of publication of this
Public Notice. Written com-
ments must be post-
marked and all facsimile
comments must be received
by the close of business
(5:00 pm), on or before the
end of this 30-day period, by
the permitting authority's
office or facsimile, as listed
below. As part of his or her
comments, any person may
also request that the per-
mitting authority hold a
public meeting on this per-
mitting action. If the
permitting authority
determines there is
sufficient interest for a
public meeting, it will pub-
lish notice of the time, date,
and location on the Depart-
ment's official web site for
notices at [http://thora6.
dep.state.fl.us/onw](http://thora6.dep.state.fl.us/onw) and in a
newspaper of general circ-
ulation in the area affected
by the permitting action. For
additional information, con-
tact the permitting auth-
ority's office at the address
and phone number listed
below. If written comments
or comments received at a
public meeting result in a
significant change to the

Permit Renewal, the permitting authority shall issue a Revised DRAFT Title V Air Operation Permit Renewal and require, if applicable, another Public Notice. All comments filed will be made available for public inspection.

Any person whose substantial interests are affected by the proposed permitting decision may petition for an administrative hearing in accordance with Section 120.569 and 120.57 of the Florida Statutes (F.S.). The petition must contain the information set forth below and must be filed (received) in Office of General Counsel of the Department of Environmental Protection, 3900 Commonwealth Boulevard, Mail Station #35, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-3000 (Telephone: 850/245-2242; Fax: 850/245-2303).

Petitions filed by any person other than those entitled to written notice under Section 120.60(3), F.S., must be filed within fourteen days of publication of the public notice or within fourteen days of receipt of the notice of intent, whichever occurs first. Under Section 120.60(3), F.S., however, any person who asked the permitting authority for notice of agency action may file a petition within fourteen days of receipt of that notice, regardless of the date of publication. A petitioner shall mail a copy of the petition to the applicant at the address indicated above, at the time of filing.

The failure of any person to file a petition within the applicable time period shall constitute a waiver of that person's right to request an administrative determination (hearing) under Sections 120.569 and 120.57, F.S., or to intervene in this proceeding and participate as a party to it. Any subsequent intervention will be only at the approval of the presiding officer upon the filing of a motion in compliance with Rule 28-106-205, F.A.C.

A petition that disputes the material facts on which the permitting authority's action is based must contain the following information:

- The name and address of each agency affected and each agency's file or identification number, if known;
- The name, address, and telephone number of the petitioner; the name, address and telephone number of the petitioner's representative, if any, which shall be the address for service purposes during the course of the proceeding; and an explanation of how the petitioner's substantial interests will be affected by the agency determination;
- A statement of how and when each petitioner received notice of the agency action or proposed action;

- A statement of all disputed issues of material fact. If there are none, the petition must so indicate;
- A concise statement of the ultimate facts alleged, as well as the rules and statutes which entitle the petitioner to relief;
- A statement of the specific rules or statutes the petitioner contends require reversal or modification of the agency's proposed action; and
- A statement of the relief sought by the petitioner, stating precisely the action petitioner wishes the agency to take with respect to the agency's proposed action.

A petition that does not dispute the material facts upon which the permitting authority's action is based shall state that no such facts are in dispute and otherwise shall contain the same information as set forth above, as required by Rule 28-106-301, F.A.C.

Because the administrative hearing process is designed to formulate final agency action, the filing of a petition means that the permitting authority's final action may be different from the position taken by it in this notice of intent. Persons whose substantial interests will be affected by any such final decision of the permitting authority on the application(s) have the right to petition to become a party to the proceeding, in accordance with the requirements set forth above.

Mediation is not available for this proceeding.

In addition to the above, pursuant to 42 United States Code (U.S.C.) Section 7661d(b)(2), any person may petition the Administrator of the EPA within 60 (sixty) days of the expiration of the Administrator's 45 (forty-five) day review period as established at 42 U.S.C. Section 7661d(b)(1), to object to issuance to any Title V Permit. Any petition shall be based only on objections to the permits that were raised with reasonable specificity during the 30 (thirty) day public comment period provided in this notice, unless the petitioner demonstrates to the Administrator of the EPA that it was impracticable to raise such objections within the comment period or unless the grounds for such objection arose after the comment period. Filing of a petition with the Administrator of the EPA does not stay the effective date of any Title V Permit properly issued pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 62-213, F.A.C. Petitions filed with the Administrator of EPA must meet the requirements of 42 U.S.C.
