RE: Clean Air Act Notification 112(j) Major Source of Hazardous Air Pollutants North County Resource Recovery Facility – Class I & III MSW Landfills Title V Air Operating Permit No. 0990234-001-AV

Dear Ms. Phillips:

As required by the April 5, 2002 correspondence from your agency, this letter serves as the Clean Air Act 112(j) notification informing you that the Class I & III Municipal Solid Waste (MSW) Landfills located at the North County Resource Recovery Facility may be a major source of hazardous air pollutants (HAPs). A Title V Air Operating Permit (No. 0990234-001-AV) has been issued for the North County Resource Facility which consists of a municipal waste combustor plant designed to process and burn refuse derived fuel (RDF) and two MSW landfills that are also on this property. This facility is located at 7501 North Jog Road in West Palm Beach, Florida. According to the Title V Permit, this entire facility has been classified a major source of HAPs.

The Class I & Class III Landfills each have their own separate gas collection system and flares, giving a total of two (2) identified emission units. Additionally, the MWC plant has two boilers, which have also been identified as two (2) emission units under this Title V Permit.
