Subject: Request for Additional Information – Shady Hills Generating Station (PSD-FL-402A)

Dear Mr. Belden:

It is our understanding that on July 14, 2010, you submitted to the Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP) an Air Construction Permit application and revised best available control technology analysis for the Shady Hills Generating Station to be located in Pasco County in Spring Hill, Florida. The permit application does not contain emission estimations for greenhouse gases (GHGs). As you may be aware, for construction projects in Florida which trigger prevention of significant deterioration (PSD) permitting for GHG emissions, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) Region 4 will be the permitting authority. Please submit an estimation of GHG emissions to us at the following address as soon as possible in order for us to determine if GHG emissions from your proposed construction project are subject to federal PSD permitting requirements (40 CFR 52.21).
