Good afternoon David.

I have attached the document you requested, waiver the permitting clock for an additional thirty days. In addition to our telephone discussion earlier today, I understand there is the possibility of amending the permit application to include the combustion of the equipment flush, which I strongly suspect will be ethanol. I suspect the volume of this material will be very small in comparison to the volume of the bio-oil to be burner; i.e., a de minimis quantity.

Also, because of design, fabrication and delivery of the fuel delivery skid, the execution date of this project is approaching the permanent shutdown date (06/01/09) for the steam units at Bartow. I wanted to explore the possibility of including the Anclote plant's steam units in the application as a possible substitute for the Bartow steam units. If this is possible, please advise how to proceed to pursue this addition.
