A petition that disputes the material facts on which the permitting uthority's action is based must contain the following information:

(a) The name and address of each agency affected and each gency's file or identification number, if known;

(b) The name, address and telephone number of the petitioner's presentative, if any, which shall be the address for service purposes uring the course of the proceeding; and an explanation of how etitioner's substantial rights will be affected by the agency action or proposed action;

(c) A statement of how and when the petitioner received notice the agency action or proposed action;

(c) A statement of how and when the petitioner received notice of the agency action or proposed action;

(d) A statement of all disputed issues of material fact. If there are none, the petition must so state;

(e) A concise statement of the ultimate facts alleged, as well as the rules and statutes which entitle petitioner to relief; and

A petition that does not dispute the material facts upon which the permitting authority's action is based shall state that no such facts are in dispute and otherwise shall contain the same information as set forth above, as required by Rule 28-106.30). F.A.C.

Because the administrative hearing process is designed to formulate final agency action, the filling of a petition means that the permitting authority's final action may be different from the position taken by it in this notice of intent. Persons whose substantial interests will be affected by any such final decision of the permitting authority on the application have the right to petition to become a party to the proceeding, in accordance with the requirements set forth above.

Mediation is not available for this proceeding, in addition to the above, pursuant to 42 United States (U.S.C.)
