The Department of Environmental Protection (permitting authority) gives notice of its Intent to
Sistue a Title V air operation permit revision to Lakeland Electric for the C.D. Michtosh, Jr. Power Plant

The subject of the permit revision is to incorporate a newly constructed stationary gas furinine.
Emissions Unit 1.D. - 022. This unit is an Acid Rain unit. The revision also incorporates a liquid fuel storage tank for this turbine, Emissions Unit 1.D. - 029, into the list of unregulated emissions unit.
The permitting authority will issue the PROPOSED Title V Permit Revision, and subsequent FINAL
Title V Permit Revision, in accordance with the conditions of the DRAFT Title V Permit Revision unless
gresponse réceived in accordance with the following procedures results in a different decision or
spinificant change of terms or conditions.

The permitting authority will accept written comments concerning the proposed DRAFT Title V
Permit Revision issuance action for a period of 30 (thinly) does from the date of publication of this

A petition that does not dispute the material facts upon which the permitting authority's action is based shall state that no such facts are in dispute and otherwise shall contain the same information as set forth above, as required by Rule 28-104.301. FA.C.

Because the administrative hearing process is designed to formulate final agency action, the filling of a petition means that the permitting authority's final action may be different from the position taken by it in this notice of intent, Persons whose substantial interests will be affected by any such final decision of the permitting authority on the application have the right to petition to become a party to the proceeding, in accordance with the requirements set forth above.

Mediation is not available for this proceeding.

In addition to the above, pursuant to 42 United States Code (U.S.C.) Section 7661d(b)(2); any person may petition the Administrator of the EPA within 60 (sixty) days of the explication of the Administrator \$45 (cnty-five) day review period as established at 42 U.S.C. Section 7661d(b)(3), to object to issuance of any permit revision. Any petition shall be based only on objections to the permit that were raised with reasonable specificity during the 30 (thirty) day public comment period provided in this notice, unless the petitioner demonstrates to the Administrator of the EPA that it was impracticable to raise such objections within the comment, period or unless the grounds for such objection arose after the comment period; properly issued pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 62-213, F.A.C. Petitions filled with the Administrator of the EPA at: U.S.EPA, 401 M Street, S.W., Washington, D.C. 20400.
