We are in receipt of your letter dated October 19, 2001 addressed to Mr. Keith Hulbert (Lakeland Electric's Responsible Official) requesting additional information due to our e-mail request of October 17, 2001. We understand that the Department feels if the words "permitting note" are omitted in these permits it may necessitate a revision to the Title V instead of an administrative permit change. We thank you for having brought this to our attention.
