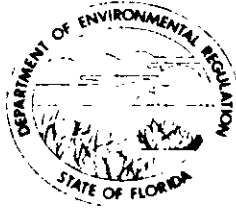

IMC New Wales Operations is hereby requesting an extension until July 1, 1984, on the following Construction Permits:

- Tpa* AC53-19051 #3 Phosphoric Acid Plant *10/30/83*
- Tpa* AC53-22671 GTSP Truck/Rail Loadout *12/1/82*
- CAPS* AC53-23546 #2 Diammonium Phosphate Plant *9/30/83*

As discussed with you during a recent meeting, IMC New Wales Operations had completed construction of its Third Train Expansion in late 1981. However, due to economic reasons, some of these units have not yet been put into operation except for mechanical checkout. Therefore, the compliance testing required prior to submission for an Operating Permit cannot be completed. It is now our best estimate that these units will not be put into service prior to the spring or early summer of 1984.

We therefore request that this extension be granted based upon the facts presented above.

Dear Mrs. Tschinkel:

Pursuant to Specific Condition, Number 9 of the above referenced Construction Permit, International Minerals & Chemical Corporation, New Wales Operations, is hereby filing its semi-annual progress report.

Effective as of January 1, 1982, construction of the dual train unit diammonium phosphate plant has been 100% completed. The East unit was started up on November 3, 1981, and the West unit on November 9, 1981, for the purpose of equipment checkout and contractual acceptance. However, due to the economic conditions existing in the fertilizer industry, the plant was taken out of service on December 2, 1981, and is not expected to be restarted for some period of time. Limited testing on the scrubber units indicated that compliance with the Permit limits will be met.

The Construction Permit does not expire until September 30, 1983. We anticipate that economic conditions will allow for startup of this operation prior to the expiration date and an operating permit will be applied for as soon as restart allows compliance testing to be performed.
