The Department received your letter on April 20, 2007, submitted on behalf of Mosaic Fertilizer, LLC, New Wales Plant, requesting an extension of the expiration date of the above referenced permit from June 30, 2007 to December 31, 2008. After reviewing all the submitted information, we have determined that additional information is needed in order to continue processing this extension request. Please submit the information requested below to the Department's Bureau of Air Regulation (BAR):


1. Specific Condition 23 of the construction permit (1050059-036-AC) required the permittee to notify BAR of commencement of construction activity for all the emission units included in the construction permit. The condition also required submittal of quarterly reports on the progress of construction activities for all of the emission units during that quarter. The Department cannot reconcile the construction activity listed in the letter with those listed in the quarterly reports. Please provide documentation to show that the construction activities listed in your letter took place and explain why they were not included in the quarterly progress reports.
2. Please provide a PE sealed statement when responding to this request for additional information.

The Department will resume processing this request after receipt of the requested information. Rule 62-4.050(3), F.A.C. requires that all applications for a Department permit

must be certified by a professional engineer registered in the State of Florida. This requirement also applies to responses to Department requests for additional information of an engineering nature. A new certification statement by the authorized representative or responsible official must accompany any material changes to the application. Rule 62-4.055(1), F.A.C. now requires applicants to respond to requests for information within 90 days.
