Protection (Department) Protection (Department) gives notice of its intention in the polk Polk Power Partners LP, Inc. for the Mulberry Cogeneration Facility located at 3600 County Road 555, Bartow, Polk County The applicant's name and address are Polk Power Partners LP, Inc. 1125 US 98, South, Suite 100 Lakeland, Florida 33801

The Department will issue the combined Draft Air Construction Permit / Title V PRO-POSED Operation Permit Renewal, and subsequent com-bined Final Air Construction Permit / Title V FINAL Opera tion Permit Renewal, in accor dance with the conditions of the attached Draft Air Construction Permit / Title V DRAFT Operation Permit Renewal unless a response re ceived in accordance with the following procedures results in a different decision or signifi-cant change of terms or conditions. The Department has de-termined that a combined Air Construction Permit / Title V Operation Permit Renewal Is required in order to: renew the Title V permit, eliminate the requirement to conduct annual tests for volatile organic com-pounds and allow the use of the Acid Rain required nitrogen oxides continuous emissions monitors as the compliance method for the gas turbine at the Mulberry Cogeneration Fa-

cility in Polk County.

The Department will accept written comments concerning the proposed combined Draft Air Construction Permit / Title V DRAFT Operation Permit Renewal for a period of thirty (30) days from the date of

publication of this notice. Written comments should be provided to the Department's Bu-reau of Air Regulations at 2500 Blair Stone Road, Mail Station #5505, Tallahassee, FL 32399-2400. Any written comments filed shall be made available for public inspection. If written comments received result in a significant change in this com-bined Draft Air Construction Permit / Title V DRAFT Operation Permit Renewal, the Department shall issue a com-bined Revised Draft Air Con-struction Permit / Title V struction Permit / Title V DRAFT Operation Permit Renewal and require, if applicable, another Public Notice.

A person whose substantial interests are affected by the proposed permitting decision may petition for an administrative proceeding (hearing) under Sections 120.569 and 120.57 of the Florida Statutes. The petition must contain the information set forth below and must be filed (received) in the Office of General Counsel of the Department at 3900 Commonwealth Boulevard, Mail Station #35, Tallahassee, Florida, 32399-3000. Petitions filed by the permit applicant or any of the parties listed below must be filed within fourteen (14) days of receipt of this notice of intent. Petitions filed by any persons other than those entitied to written notice under Section 120.60(3) of the Florida gStatutes gmust ; be · filed within fourteen days of publication of the public notice or within fourteen days of f receipt of this notice of intent, whichever occurs first. Under Section 120.60(3), however, any person who asked the Department for notice of agency action may file a petition within fourteen (14) days of receipt of that notice, regardless of the date of publication. A petitioner shall mail a copy of the petition to the arplicant at the address indicated above at the time of filing. The failure of any person to file a petition within the appropriate time period shall constitute a waiver of that person's right to request an administrative determination (hearing) under Sections 120.569 and 120.57 F.S., or to intervene in this proceeding and participate as a party to it. Any subsequent intervention will be only at the approval of the presiding officer upon the filing of a motion in compliance with Rule 28-106.205 of the Florida Administrative Code.

A petition that disputes the material facts on which the Department's action is based must contain the following information: (a) The name and address of each agency affected and each agency's file or identification number, if known; (b) The name, address, and telephone number of the petitioner, the name, address and telephone number of the petitioner's representative, if any, which shall be the address for service purposes during the course of the proceeding; and an explanation of how the peti-tioner's substantial interests will be affected by the agency determination; (c) A statement of how and when petitioner received notice of the agency action or proposed action; (d) A statement of all disputed issues of material fact. If there are none, the petition must so indicate; (e) A concise state-ment of the ultimate facts alleged, as well as the rules and statutes which entitle the peti-tioner to relief; and (f) A demand for relief.

A petition that does not dispute the material facts upon which the Department's action is based shall state that no such facts are in dispute and otherwise shall contain the same information as set forth above, as required by Rule 28-106 ao1, F.A.C. Because the administrative hearing process is designed to formulate final agency action, the filing of a petition means that the Department's final action may be different from the position taken by it in this notice. Persons whose substantial interests will be affected by any such final decision of the Department on the application have the right to petition to become a party to the pro-ceeding, in accordance with the requirements set forth above. Mediation is not available for

this proceeding.
In addition to the above, pursuant to 42 United States Code (U.S.C.) Section 7661d(b)(2), any person may petition the Administrator of the EPA within 60 (sixty) days of the expiration of the Administrator's 45 (forty-five) day review period as established at 42 U.S.C. Section 7661d(b)(1), to object to issuance of any permit. Any petition shall be based only on objections to the permit that were raised with reasonable specificity during the 30 (thirty) day public comment period provided in this notice, unless the petitioner demonstrates to the Administrator of the EPA that it was impracticable to raise such objections within the comment period or unless the grounds for such objection arose after the comment period. Filing of a petition with the Administrator of the EPA does not stay the effective date of any permit properly issued pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 62-213, F.A.C. Petitions filed with the Administrator of EPA must meet the requirements of 42 U.S.C. Section 7661d(b)(2) and must be filed with the Administrator of the EPA at: U.S. EPA, 401 M. Street, S.W., Washington, DC 20460.
