Dear Ms. Vielhauer:

The purpose of this letter is to request a one year extension to the expiration date of Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP) AC Permit No. 1050233-021-AC / PSD-FL-194H. This construction permit, which was issued on June 26, 2008 and expires on June 1, 2009, authorized an increase in the petroleum coke blend ratio allowed to be gasified at the Polk Power Station Unit 1 integrated gasification combined cycle (IGCC) facility.

The reason for the permit extension request is that Polk Power Station Unit 1 is now returning from a scheduled major outage. Maintenance work done during the outage may increase the efficiency of sulfur removal from the syngas prior to combustion in the turbine. Per Section 3, Condition No. 6, no later than 180 days after completing the upgrades to the sulfuric acid plant and the MDEA acid gas removal system, stack testing shall be performed. In order to meet this requirement, stack testing and report submittal to the Department can not be accomplished prior to the current permit's expiration date, thus the request for an extension of the expiration date. TEC had previously advised the Department in comments on the draft air construction permit that it was likely an extension of the permit expiration date would be necessary; reference our letter to the Department dated June 18, 2008.. The requested extension to the air construction permit expiration date will allow time for TEC to complete all of the initial performance tests required by AC Permit No. 1050233-021-AC and to submit a Title V permit revision application in accordance with the timeframes specified by Rule 62-213.420, F.A.C.

Dear Mr. Hornick:

On April 2, 2009, the Department of Environmental Protection (Department) received your application for an extension of the expiration date of air construction permit, No. 1050233-021-AC/PSD-FL-194H, which expires on June 1, 2009. The permit authorized an increase in the petroleum coke blend ratio allowed to be gasified at the Tampa Electric Company's (TECO's) Polk Power Station Unit 1 integrated gasification combined cycle facility. Unit 1 is now returning from a scheduled major outage, which may allow for an increase in the efficiency of sulfur removal from the syngas prior to combustion in the turbine. Since the authorized work has been completed, all that is left to be done to Unit 1 is to troubleshoot the system, conduct performance tests, submit the performance test reports and apply for incorporation of the applicable requirements into a Title V air operation permit. The request is being made because there isn't sufficient time to complete this work.

Based on the circumstances and information provided, the Department approves the request to extend the expiration date.

Determination: The expiration date of air construction permit No. 1050233-021-AC/PSD-FL-194H is hereby extended from **June 1, 2009 to June 30, 2010**, to provide the necessary time to troubleshoot the system, conduct performance tests, submit the performance test reports and apply for incorporation of the applicable requirements into a Title V air operation permit. A copy of this letter shall be filed with the referenced permit and shall become part of the permit. This permitting decision is issued pursuant to Chapter 403, Florida Statutes (F.S.).

Permitting Authority: Applications for air construction permits are subject to review in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 403, F.S., and Chapters 62-4, 62-210 and 62-212 of the Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.). The Permitting Authority responsible for making a permit determination for this project is the Bureau of Air Regulation in the Department's Division of Air Resource Management. The Permitting Authority's physical address is: 111 South Magnolia Drive, Suite #4, Tallahassee, Florida. The Permitting Authority's mailing address is: 2600 Blair Stone Road, MS #5505, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-2400. The Permitting Authority's telephone number is 850/488-0114.

Petitions: A person whose substantial interests are affected by the proposed permitting decision may petition for an administrative hearing in accordance with Sections 120.569 and 120.57, F.S. The petition must contain the information set forth below and must be filed with (received by) the Department's Agency Clerk in the Office of General Counsel of the Department of Environmental Protection, 3900 Commonwealth Boulevard, Mail Station #35, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-3000 (Telephone: 850/245-2241). Petitions must be filed within 14 days of receipt of this permit extension. A petitioner shall mail a copy of the petition to the applicant at the address indicated above, at the time of filing. The failure of any person to file a petition within the appropriate time period shall constitute a waiver of that person's right to request an administrative determination (hearing) under Sections 120.569 and 120.57, F.S., or to intervene in this proceeding and participate as a party to it. Any subsequent intervention (in a proceeding initiated by another party) will be only at the approval of the presiding officer upon the filing of a motion in compliance with Rule 28-106.205, F.A.C.

A petition that disputes the material facts on which the Permitting Authority's action is based must contain the following information: (a) The name and address of each agency affected and each agency's file or identification number, if known; (b) The name, address, and telephone number of the petitioner; the name, address and telephone number of the petitioner's representative, if any, which shall be the address for service purposes during the course of the proceeding; and an explanation of how the petitioner's substantial interests will be affected by the agency determination; (c) A statement of when and how each petitioner received notice of the agency action or proposed decision; (d) A statement of all disputed issues of material fact; (e) A concise statement of the ultimate facts alleged, including the specific facts the petitioner contends warrant reversal or modification of the agency's proposed action; (f) A statement of the specific rules or statutes the petitioner contends require reversal or modification of the agency's proposed action including an explanation of how the alleged facts relate to the specific rules or statutes; and, (g) A statement of the relief sought by the petitioner, stating precisely the action the petitioner wishes the agency to take with respect to the agency's proposed action. A petition that does not dispute the material facts upon which the Permitting Authority's action is based shall state that no such facts are in dispute and otherwise shall contain the same information as set forth above, as required by Rule 28-106.301, F.A.C.


Because the administrative hearing process is designed to formulate final agency action, the filing of a petition means that the Permitting Authority's final action may be different from the position taken by it in this written notice. Persons whose substantial interests will be affected by any such final decision of the Permitting Authority on the application have the right to petition to become a party to the proceeding, in accordance with the requirements set forth above.

Mediation: Mediation is not available in this proceeding.

Effective Date: This permitting decision is final and effective on the date filed with the clerk of the Department unless a petition is filed in accordance with the above paragraphs or unless a request for extension of time in which to file a petition is filed within the time specified for filing a petition pursuant to Rule 62-110.106, F.A.C., and the petition conforms to the content requirements of Rules 28-106.201 and 28-106.301, F.A.C. Upon timely filing of a petition or a request for extension of time, this action will not be effective until further order of the Department.

Judicial Review: Any party to this permitting decision (order) has the right to seek judicial review of it under Section 120.68, F.S., by filing a notice of appeal under Rule 9.110 of the Florida Rules of Appellate Procedure with the clerk of the Department in the Office of General Counsel, Mail Station #35, 3900 Commonwealth Boulevard, Tallahassee, Florida, 32399-3000, and by filing a copy of the notice of appeal accompanied by the applicable filing fees with the appropriate District Court of Appeal. The notice must be filed within 30 days after this order is filed with the clerk of the Department.


