Project: The applicant pro-poses to modify the flos. 4 Lime Kiin. Recovery Boller and Multiple Effect Evapora-tors, and the No. 5 Power Boller. The project will result in the following potential emissions increases: 1473 tons/year of carbon monoxide (CO): 405 tons/year of carbon (CO); 405 tons/year of nitro-gen oxides (NOx); 105 lons/year of particulate mat-ter (PM); 64 tons/year of par-ticulate matter with an seroliculate matter with an sero-dynamic diameter of 10 mi-crons or less (PM10); 4.2 tonsylver of sulfurle acid mist; and 418 tonsylves of volatile organic compounds (VOC). The project includes Conversion of the No. 5 Pow-er Roller Coner Boiler from a primary fuel of residual oil to natural gas. This will result in a reduction of more than 3400 lone per year of sulfur dioxide. Pursuant to Rule 62-212,400, F.A.C., the project is subject to preconstruction review for the prevention of sig-nificant deterioration (PSD) of niticant deterioration (PSD) of air quality for emissions of CO, NOx, PM, PM10, and VOC.
