DeBary, Florida 2735-0179. Facility Location: The applicant oberates the existing Turner Power Plant, which is located at 201 Debary Avenue, Delona in Volusia County, Florida 2701-20179. Facility Location: The applicant operation permit renewal. This is a renewal of Title V air operation permit No. 1270020-0002-AV. This existing facility consists of tour simple cycle combustion turbine peaking units (CTP Nos. 1, 2, 3 and 4), all of which are pre-NSPS emissions units. Air pollutant emissions from the CTP are not controlled and each turbine exhausts through a separate stack. CTP Nos. and 2 began commercial service on October 9, 1970. CTP Nos. 3 and 4 began commercial service on June 14, 1974. The three fossil fuel fired steam generators (SG Nos. 2, 3 and 4) were permanently retired on January 1, 1998; these units were completely dismantled early 2008 and have been removed from the facility. Also included in this permit are miscellaneous unregulatedinsignificant emissions units and/or activities.

Permitting Authority: Applications for Title V air operation permits are subject to review in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 403. Florida Statutes (E-S.) and Chapters 62-4, 62-210 and 62-213 of the Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.). Objections: Finally, pursuant to 42 United States Code (U.S.C.) Section 7661d(b)(2), any person may petition the Administrator of the EPA within 60 days of the expiration of the Administrator's 45-day review period as established at 42 U.S.C. Section 7661d(b)(1), to object to the issuance of any TiNe V air operation permit. Any petition shall be based only on objections to the permit that were raised with reasonable specificity during the 30-day public comment period provided in the Public Notice, unless the petitioner demonstrates to the Administrator of the EPA that it was impracticable to raise such objections within the comment period or unless the grounds for such objection arose after the comment period. Filing of a petition with the Administrator of the EPA does not stay the effective date of any permit properly issued pursuant to the Provisions of Chapter 62-213, F.A.C.
