## REQUEST FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

By and through undersigned counsel, City of Tallahassee (Tallahassee) hereby requests, pursuant to Florida Administrative Code Rules 28-106.111(3) and 62-103.050(1), an extension of time, to and including June 20, 1997, in which to file a Petition for Administrative Proceedings or a Request for Mediation in the above-styled matter. As good cause for granting this request, Tallahassee states the following:

- 1. On or about March 25, 1997, Tallahassee received from the Department of Environmental Protection (Department) an "Intent to Issue Title V Air Operation Permit" (Permit No. 1290001-001-AV) for the Sam O. Purdom Generating Station in Wakulla County, Florida. Along with the Intent to Issue, Tallahassee received a draft Title V permit and "Public Notice of Intent to Issue Title V Air Operation Permit." Supplemental "replacement" pages to the draft permit were received on or about April 18, 1997.
- 2. By Orders dated April 30, 1997 and May 22, 1997, the Department formally granted Tallahassee until June 9, 1997, within which to file a Petition for Administrative Proceedings or a Request for Mediation.

- 3. The draft permit contains several provisions that warrant clarification or correction.
- 4. Representatives of Tallahassee have corresponded with staff of the Department's Bureau of Air Regulation, and several of the issues identified by Tallahassee have been resolved. A few important issues remain, and Tallahassee will continue to correspond with Department staff to finally resolve these remaining issues.
- 5. This request is filed simply as a protective measure to avoid waiver of Tallahassee's right to challenge certain conditions contained in the draft Title V permit. Grant of this request will not prejudice either party, but will further their mutual interest and likely avoid the need to file a petition and proceed to a formal administrative hearing or formal mediation.
- 6. On behalf of the Department, Jeffrey Brown with the Department's Office of General Counsel has agreed to Tallahassee's request for an extension of time until June 20, 1997.

WHEREFORE, Tallahassee respectfully requests that the time for filing of a Petition for Administrative Proceedings or a Request for Mediation in regard to the Department's Intent to Issue Title V Air Operation Permit for Permit No. 1290001-001-AV be formally extended to and including June 20, 1997.

#### SUPPLEMENTAL REQUEST FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

By and through undersigned counsel, City of Tallahassee (Tallahassee) hereby supplements its previous request for an extension of time, to and including June 9, 1997, in which to file a Petition for Administrative Proceedings or a Request for Mediation in the above-styled matter. Pursuant to Florida Administrative Code Rules 28-106.111(3) and 62-103.050(1), the previous request was filed on April 8, 1997. As good cause for granting this supplemental request, Tallahassee states the following:

- 1. On or about March 25, 1997, Tallahassee received from the Department of Environmental Protection (Department) an "Intent to Issue Title V Air Operation Permit" (Permit No. 1290001-001-AV) for the Sam O. Purdom Generating Station in Wakulla County, Florida. Along with the Intent to Issue, Tallahassee received a draft Title V permit and "Public Notice of Intent to Issue Title V Air Operation Permit."
- 2. Tallahassee filed a Request for Extension of Time on April 8, 1997, and by Order dated April 30, 1997, the Department formally granted that request. Tallahassee was given until June 9, 1997, within which to file a Petition for Administrative Proceedings or a Request for Mediation.

- 3. Subsequent to receipt of the original draft permit, Tallahassee received (via facsimile) several "replacement pages" for the draft permit on or about April 18, 1997.
- 4. Receipt of the replacement pages should not be considered a new point of entry and should instead be considered part of the draft permit, based on the undersigned's interpretation of the Department's April 18 letter and conversations between Department and Tallahassee representatives.
- 5. This request is filed simply as a protective measure to avoid waiver of Tallahassee's right to challenge certain conditions contained in the draft Title V permit received on or about March 25, 1997, as well as the replacement pages received on or about April 18, 1997, should a contrary interpretation be made by the Department or a third party.
- 6. Grant of this request will not prejudice either party, but will further their mutual interest and likely avoid the need to file a petition and proceed to a formal administrative hearing or formal mediation.
- 7. On behalf of the Department, Jeffrey Brown with the Office of General Counsel has agreed to Tallahassee's request for an extension of time until June 9, 1997, for the draft permit. Counsel for Tallahassee contacted Jeffrey Brown regarding this supplemental request and Counsel knows of no objections by the Department.

WHEREFORE, Tallahassee respectfully requests that the time for filing of a Petition for Administrative Proceedings or a Request for Mediation in regard to the Department's original Intent to Issue Title V Air Operation Permit for Permit No. 1290001-001-AV, as well as the subsequently issued "replacement pages," be formally extended to and including June 9, 1997.
