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

The Sam O. Purdom Generating Station is an electric production facility consisting of one steam generating unit (Unit 7 produces a nominal 48 MW), two simple cycle gas turbines (GT1 and GT2 produce a nominal 11.3 MW each), and a combined cycle combustion turbine (Unit 8 produces a nominal 160 MW from the gas turbine and a nominal 90 MW from the heat recovery steam generator).

This form is submitted to the agency as the Part 1 Notification of 40 CFR 63, Subpart YYYY for the two simple cycle combustion turbines and the combined cycle combustion turbine located at the facility. These units are designated as Emission Unit -008 (GT1), Emission Unit -009 (GT2) and Emission Unit -012 (Unit 8) in the Title V permit (Permit No. 1290001-003-AV).

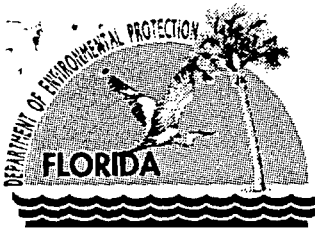
