I. Comment(s).

No comments were received from the USEPA during their 45 day review period of the PROPOSED Permit.

II. Conclusion.

Minor changes to the DRAFT/PROPOSED permit were noted by the Facility. The corrected name for the compliance agency of The City of Jacksonville is Environmental and Compliance Department (ECD). ECD's new address is: 407 N. Laura Street, 3rd Floor, Jacksonville, Florida 32202. Correction to Specific Condition C.2- FROM: **Methods of Operation**. This emissions unit may be fired with either natural gas, No. 2 fuel Oil, No. 6 fuel Oil, a blend of No. 2 fuel oil with Glidfuel, or a blend of No. 6 fuel oil with Glidfuel. At no time shall the firing of the fuels exceed the 93.0 MMBtu/hr heat input of the boiler. Vapors from the vapor collection system are also incinerated in this emissions unit. TO: **Methods of Operation**. This emissions unit may be fired with either natural gas, No. 2 fuel Oil, No. 6 fuel Oil, a blend of No. 2 fuel oil with Glidfuel, or a blend of No. 6 fuel oil with Glidfuel. At no time shall the firing of the fuels exceed the 117.0 MMBtu/hr heat input of the boiler. Vapors from the vapor collection system are also incinerated in this emissions unit.

In conclusion, the permitting authority hereby issues the FINAL Permit.
