Pursuant to Section 403.0872(6), Florida Statutes, if no objection to the proposed Title V air operation permit is made by the U.S. EPA within 45 days, the proposed permit will become a final permit no later than 55 days after the date on which the proposed permit was mailed (posted) to U.S. EPA. If U.S. EPA has an objection to the proposed permit, the final permit will not be issued until the permitting authority receives written notice that the objection is resolved or withdrawn.

This Title V air operation permit was processed using a sequential review.

PUBLIC NOTICE

A Written Notice of Intent to Issue Air Permit issued to NRG Florida, L.P. for the Osceola Power Plant located at 8400 Community Center Road, Saint Cloud in Osceola County, was clerked on July 14, 2017.

The Public Notice of Intent to Issue Air Permit was published in the Orlando Sentinel on July 21, 2017. The draft Title V air operation permit was available for public inspection at the permitting authority's office in Tallahassee. Proof of publication of the Public Notice of Intent to Issue Air Permit was received on July 21, 2017.

U.S. EPA REVIEW

The Department informed the U.S. EPA Region 4 Office that this Title V air operation permit was being processed using a sequential review by virtue of the draft permit being issued on July 14, 2017.

COMMENTS

No comments on the permit were received from the public or Applicant during the 30-day public comment period.
